If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. 3. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.
4. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. 5. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -
  1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
  2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
  3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated

cost.

6. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
- If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

**6. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. The hiring of vehicles shall be for a period of two years from the date of award of contract or till the completion of Census-2027 works (including Caste Enumeration), whichever is earlier.
2. The vehicles deployed shall be duly insured and shall possess all statutory permits/clearances from the competent Transport Authority or any other concerned authority, including valid RC, Taxi Permit, Fitness Certificate, Insurance, and Pollution Under Control (PUC) etc. All such documents shall remain valid throughout the contract period.
3. The service provider shall be responsible for maintaining the hired vehicles in a neat, clean, hygienic, and scratch-free condition as far as possible. Vehicles shall be sanitized daily with disinfectant, and the upholstery shall be clean and well maintained.
4. This Office shall not be responsible for any challan, loss, damage, accident, injury to the driver, or injury/damage to any third party. Any loss, damage, compensation, or legal expenses arising therefrom shall be borne entirely by the contracted agency.
5. The hired vehicles shall be used for outstation journeys throughout Kerala, as and when required. The agency shall provide vehicles along with drivers willing to undertake outstation journeys for multiple consecutive days.
6. Time and mileage shall be calculated from the time and place of reporting to the time and place of release of the vehicle, including during outstation journeys. Garage-to-garage basis shall not be applicable.
7. Vehicles shall be made available on all days, including Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, as per the requirements of this Office.
8. Drivers shall strictly observe proper etiquette and protocol while on duty. They shall be neatly dressed, carry an agency-issued ID card, and possess a mobile phone in working condition, for which no separate payment shall be made by this Office.
9. Drivers shall comply with all traffic rules and Government regulations in force from time to time. Any instance of misconduct or negligence shall result in immediate replacement of the driver by the agency.

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10. Log book indicating time and mileage for each vehicle shall be maintained on regular basis. The attendance of the driver shall be ensured in adherence to this Office's duty timings.
11. The number of vehicles hired may be increased or reduced by this Office depending on requirements, and the agency shall be bound to accept such variations without any claim.
12. The bidder shall not be blacklisted by any Central/State Government Department, PSU, or Autonomous Body. A valid undertaking to this effect shall be uploaded with the bid.
13. In case of any shortfall for whatsoever reason, or in the event of breakdown of any hired vehicle, the service provider shall immediately replace the vehicle with a substitute of the same specifications. Acceptance of the substitute vehicle shall be at the sole discretion of this Office.
14. The hired vehicles shall be provided for the exclusive use of this Office and shall not be used for any other purpose by the contracting agency.
15. The service provider shall ensure the roadworthiness of the vehicles at all times and shall be responsible for regular servicing. Daily maintenance and cleaning shall be carried out in a manner that does not affect official duties.
16. The service provider shall ensure strict compliance with all applicable labour laws in force during the contract period.
17. The successful bidder shall furnish the name and address of the driver along with a copy of the valid driving licence. After commencement of the contract, change of driver or vehicle shall not be made without the prior approval of this Office.
18. The liability of this Directorate shall be limited to payment of hiring charges only. The hiring charges shall be inclusive of fuel, lubricants, spare parts, maintenance, repairs, salary/wages of drivers and staff, insurance, road tax, and all other related expenses including the accommodation and other expenses of the driver during the outstation journey.
19. Each vehicle shall be provided with a trained, well-mannered, dedicated driver having a minimum of three years' driving experience. The vehicles shall be equipped with an emergency medical kit and a fire extinguisher.

20. The service provider shall ensure that the odometer is properly sealed to prevent tampering or inflation of kilometre readings. Any tampered or defective odometer shall be rectified at an authorized workshop at the cost of the service provider.

21. Driver(s) engaged under this contract shall not be treated as Government servants on any ground, including the fact that the use of vehicles for official duties.

22. This Office reserves the right to terminate the contract by giving 30 days' notice to the agency. The decision of this Office in this regard shall be final and binding on the agency.

23. Preference will be given for Electric / CNG vehicles.

#### 7. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1

bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
