- Tender line items are inseparable and non-divisible in nature.
- This tender is a single tender. All other bids, if any received other than Single nominated bidder will be summarily/categorically rejected.

2. DESCRIPTION & SCOPE OF WORK: Supply of **Boat Davit as Insurance Spares (B&D Spares) of P17A**

- Drawings and QAP: As per approved drawings and QAP for PO no. 3250000122.**
- IFATs to be conducted by OEM to inspection agency in presence of IHQ & MDL representatives.**

3. Pre-Qualification Criteria:

5. Prices: Prices shall be quoted for each line item of BoQ on all-inclusive basis as per terms and conditions of this tender as applicable for door delivery to MDL Stores. Quoted prices shall remain firm & fixed during currency of contract.

(b) The consignment must be delivered by giving at least 15 days' advance notice to Material Superintendent, Visakhapatnam, under intimation to MDL clearly indicating weight, dimensions of the consignment etc.

(c) The following Documents should be sent along with the consignment of B&D Spares as applicable:

7. **Payment Terms:**

(a) Payment of 80% of the value of the supplies and as reduced by any deductibles and / or the amount leviable towards liquidated damages, if any plus 100% taxes & duties shall be made within 15 days against generation of CRAC . . The said payment shall be made against submission of provisional receipt obtained from Material Organization, Visakhapatnam, four ink signed copies of invoices, inspection/ Test Certificate/release note from the nominated Inspection Agency, Delivery Challans/original "IN" signed Lorry Receipt duly bearing receipt stamp of Consignee &, warranty Certificate & Certificate for preservation as relevant.

(b) Payment of the balance value of the supplies (i.e. 20%) shall be payable offline as reduced by any deductibles and / or the amount leviable towards liquidated damages, if any, subject to the following:

(i) On receipt of ink signed copy of Stores Receipt Voucher (SRV) from Material Organization, Visakhapatnam.

(ii) Settlement and resolution of outstanding issues including those related to delivery and ILMS format if any.

(iii) Submission of PBG for an amount of 3% of order value, valid up to agreed Warranty period plus one-month claim period.

(iv) Balance payment will be made through Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS) / National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT) only by MDL outside GeM portal to vendor on receipt of above mentioned documents.

(v) Part payment acceptable.

8. **Payment Mode:**

(A) 80% of payment total invoiced value shall be made on GeM on receipt of following documents.

(ii) Release note from the nominated Inspection Agency,

(iv) Packing Lists,

(v) Performance Guarantee,

(vi) Storage / Preservation / Installation / Commissioning / Maintenance Procedures, / Certificate for preservation & other Technical documentation in requisite sets as relevant.

9. **Issuance of e-Invoice by Vendor:**

- i. Vendors, whose aggregate turnover in any preceding financial year from 2017-18 onwards, exceeds Rs. 5 Crores as per GST Act, will have to issue an e-Invoice with a QR code and invoice registration no (IRN). However, this rule will not apply to Micro enterprises with Udyam Registration No. (URN) as their turnover is less than Rs 5Cr.
- ii. Whenever GST is applicable, payment will be released against e-Invoice, or Invoice accompanied with v

endor's self-declaration that "We do not fall under the category of registered persons notified under Rule 48(4) of the central GST Rule 2017 and we are not required to comply with e-invoicing provisions under GST Act, as our aggregate turnover in any preceding financial year from 2017-18 onward has not exceeded Rs. 5 Cr as per GST Act".

10. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES (LD):

- i) LD clause shall be applicable as per GeM terms & conditions @ 0.5% per week for delay in delivery of material.

Note: LD is applicable with maximum ceiling as per GeM terms and conditions.

11. Performance Security (PBG): Bidders shall ensure that the validity of performance security is there as per Guarantee/Warranty requirement plus two months. In case any delay in delivery, vendor shall extend the validity of performance security suitably.

12. Guarantee/warranty Requirement: The equipment along with accessories shall be warranted for the stipulated performance for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of delivery of equipment to MO, Visakhapatnam.

- i. Goods supplied shall be guaranteed against defects in design, material and workmanship, which may appear under proper use, for a period of 12 months from the date of supply of materials at stores.
- ii. The Supplier cannot absolve their responsibility for warranty of material even though it is inspected by & approved by the inspection authorities.
- iii. If the defects are not remedied within a reasonable/stipulated time, MDL may proceed to rectify the defects at the supplier's risk & cost, but without prejudice to MDL's rights under the contract.
- iv. During the period of warranty / guarantee if any defect is noticed in the equipment / item supplied, the supplier/ contractor will have to rectify such defects immediately at no extra cost to MDL. For such rectification/repair work, if the supplier needs to take the supplied item/equipment out of MDL (in full or part), the supplier shall submit a separate BG of equivalent amount of value of item being taken out, to cover the cost of item.

13. INSPECTION: Inspection agency shall be IACS. Inspection charges to be borne by the vendor. Other general conditions related to inspection of material are as under:

14. Indemnification: The Bidder / Supplier / Contractor, his employees, licensees, agents or Sub-Supplier / Subcontractor, while on site of the Purchaser for the purpose of this contract, indemnifies the Purchaser against direct damage and/or injury to the property and/or the person of the Purchaser or that of Purchaser's employees, agents, Sub-Contractors / Suppliers occurring and to the extent caused by the negligence of the Bidder / Supplier / Contractor, his employees, licensees, agents or Subcontractor by making good such damages to the property, or compensating personal injury and the total liability for such damages or injury shall be as mutually discussed and agreed to.

It would have no liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for such action(s).

16. Purchaser's Property: All property (such as materials, drawings, documents etc) issued by the Purchaser or any other individual or firm on behalf of the Purchaser in connection with the contract shall remain confidential, being the property of the Purchaser and the Bidder/Supplier/Contractor shall undertake to return all such property so issued and will be responsible for any or all loss thereof and damage thereto resulting from whatever causes and shall reimburse the Purchaser the full amount of loss and damage.

17. Other terms & conditions:

Offer of the bidders who are debarred by MDL or issued tender holiday by MDL shall be rejected.

जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।/In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
