B. EVALUATION OF BID/ SHORT FALL DOCUMENTS :

1. All the offers will first be scrutinized to see whether they meet the basic requirements as incorporated in the bid document.
2. **The Tender Committee will examine the uploaded documents against information/declarations furnished by the bidder(s) Online/Annexures.**

Tender Committee will determine the Techno-commercial acceptability of the bidders on the basis of the original offer and subsequent clarifications/confirmation, if any.

3. After evaluation of the uploaded documents, shortfall/clarification documents, if required, shall be sought from all the bidders. **For shortfall/clarification only 01 (ONE) chance will be given. The time period for reply to the clarification will be for 7 (SEVEN) days only.** Non receipt of communication from GeM will not be accepted as a reason of non-submission of documents within prescribed time. The Bidder, whose Bid has been accepted, will be notified /communicated by the Employer electronically online on GeM portal prior to expiration of the Bid validity period. The L-1 bidder will get the information regarding award of work on their personalised dash-board on-line. On receipt of Letter of Acceptance (LOA)/Work Order/GeM Contract of the tender issued by the Company, the successful tenderer shall execute contract agreement in the company's prescribed form for the due fulfilment of the contract.

Failure to enter into the required contract within the specified period in the work order shall entail cancellation of LOA/work order/GeM Contract and forfeiture of the Earnest Money.
