1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.

3. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service

provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

5. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.

6. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
- v. If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

1. Scope of Work

- The service involves the secure and timely transportation of ordnance stores, ensuring compliance with safety and security protocols specific to such materials.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- Bidders must be registered on the GeM portal with a valid and active account.
- Bidders must have a minimum of 3 years of experience in transporting ordnance stores or similar materials for government or defense organizations.
- Bidders must possess valid licenses, permits, and registrations for operating Open Body Taurus 10 Ton vehicles, including compliance with the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, and its amendments.
- Bidders must provide the following certificates (self-attested copies):
 - a) GST Registration Certificate
 - b) PAN Card
 - c) MEME Udyam Registration Certificate (if available)
 - d) Relevant certifications for handling stores
 - e) Acceptance of Terms and Conditions
 - f) Bid Security Declaration
 - g) Certificate of Non-Blacklisting/Non-Banning
 - h) Certificate of Financial Capacity
 - i) Certificate of Non-Disclosure
 - j) Undertaking Regarding Financial Standing
- Bidders must have valid security clearance or be willing to obtain one as required by the procuring entity.
- Bids must be quoted for total tons and total vehicles, **not for a single vehicle**

3. Vehicle Specifications

- Vehicles must be Open Body Taurus 10 Ton trucks in excellent working condition.
- Vehicles must be GPS-enabled and equipped with secure locks
- Vehicles must comply with Bharat Stage VI (BS-VI) emission norms.
- Valid fitness, insurance, and Pollution Under Control (PUC) certificates are mandatory.
- Vehicles must be equipped with fire extinguishers and other safety equipment as mandated for transporting ordnance stores.

4. Service Requirements

- **Loading and Unloading:** The bidder is responsible for safe and secure loading and unloading of ordnance stores under the supervision of authorized ITBP personnel. Any damage or loss during these processes will be the bidder's liability.
 - a) Estimated time: 03 days for loading and 03 days for unloading.
 - b) The bidder is responsible for all loading/unloading logistics and associated charges.
 - c) The bidder must complete loading and unloading efficiently and keep vehicles on standby until cleared for movement.
- **Transit Time:** Transportation must be completed within 7-10 days from the date of loading, excluding force majeure events (e.g., natural calamities or government restrictions).
- **Security Protocols:** Bidders must adhere to strict security protocols, including restricted access to vehicles and goods, and compliance with defense regulations for ordnance transportation.
- **Packaging and Handling:** Stores must be covered with waterproof materials and packed as per safety norms.
 - **Route Plan:** A route plan must be submitted and approved by the buyer, avoiding restricted areas.

5. Documentation

- The Bidders must provide a list of vehicles, including registration numbers and certificates.
 - Each vehicle must carry a consignment note, e-way bill (as per GST laws), and any other documentation required for ordnance transportation.
- Proof of Delivery (POD) must be submitted to the consignee within 24 hours of delivery.
- A compliance certificate with defense norms is required.

6. Payment Terms

- Payment will be processed through the GeM portal upon successful delivery and submission of all required documents.
- No advance payment will be provided.
- Payments will be subject to applicable tax deductions, including TDS, as per applicable laws.

7. Insurance

- The bidder must ensure comprehensive insurance coverage for ordnance stores against lo

ss, damage, theft, or accidents during transit. A copy of the insurance policy must be submitted before the commencement of the service.

- The bidder is responsible for handling any insurance claims.

8. Performance Security

- The successful bidder must submit a performance security, as per GeM terms and conditions, equivalent to the prescribed percentage of the contract value, in the form of a Bank Guarantee or Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR), valid for 60 days beyond the contract period."
- Failure to perform the contract as per the terms may result in forfeiture of the performance security.

9. Penalties

- A penalty of 0.5% per day of the contract value will be imposed for delays, up to a maximum of 10%, unless caused by force majeure.
- Non-compliance with terms may lead to contract cancellation and potential blacklisting.

10. Force Majeure

- Delays due to natural disasters, strikes, or government restrictions must be reported immediately to the buyer.
- The bidder must provide evidence of force majeure events to avoid penalties.

11. Dispute Resolution

- Disputes arising from this contract will be resolved as per the dispute resolution mechanism outlined in the GeM portal guidelines.

12. Legal Compliance

- The bidder must comply with all applicable laws, including the Motor Vehicles Act, GST regulations, labor laws, and defense transport regulations.
- Drivers and staff must be licensed, trained, and briefed on security protocols.
- Legal liabilities arising from accidents or delays must be handled by the bidder, with no payment during legal delays.

13. Vehicle Readiness and Emergencies

- Vehicles must be rain- and dustproof and maintained in good condition. Repairs or replacements during transit are the bidder's responsibility.
- Unfit vehicles will be rejected, and delays due to replacements will not be compensated.
- Drivers must carry tools and spares and be trained to handle minor repairs.
- The number of trucks may change based on the final store quantity.
- Losses due to accidents or mechanical failures during transit are the bidder's responsibility, with immediate replacement and costs borne by the bidder.

14. Submission Requirements

- Bids must be submitted through the GeM portal within the specified timeline.
- Technical and financial bids must be uploaded in the prescribed format, including all required documents.

- Incomplete or non-compliant bids will be rejected without further consideration.

15. Inspection and Verification

- The procuring entity reserves the right to inspect vehicles, ordnance stores, and related documentation before, during, and after transit to ensure compliance with bid specifications and security protocols.
- The bidder must allow ITBP personnel to conduct inspections as required.

16. Termination of Contract

- The contract may be extended or terminated at the discretion of the procuring entity without reason.
 - The contract may be terminated by the procuring entity in case of repeated non-compliance, failure to deliver, or violation of security protocols or other terms.
 - Termination will be communicated in writing, and the bidder will be liable for any losses incurred by the procuring entity due to such termination.

17. Buyer Responsibilities

- The buyer will provide security guards for the transport.
- The buyer is responsible for verifying the store count during loading and unloading.

18. Additional Bidder Responsibilities

- The bidder is responsible for paying Octroi, Terminal, Sales, Service, and Toll taxes.
- All necessary documents must be obtained post-work order.
- Failure to supply trucks on time will result in forfeiture of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) and potential legal action.
- Trucks must be made available as per the schedule provided by Commandant/HOO, CWS/FAW-1, ITBP.
- Losses or shortages during transit will be recovered from the bidder.
- The speed of the vehicle should not exceed 40 km per hour, and proper distance between vehicles shall be maintained as per the directions of the convoy commander.

19. Confidentiality and Security

- The bidder shall maintain strict confidentiality regarding all information related to the ordnance stores, routes, and contract details, and shall not disclose such information to any third party without prior written consent from the procuring entity.
- All staff must be security-vetted and adhere to confidentiality protocols.

20. Additional Operational Guidelines

- The **successful bidder must provide the required vehicles within 03 days** of confirmation.
- The **driver of each truck must be thoroughly briefed** regarding the secrecy of the ordnance stores and the sensitivity of the movement. Any **suspicious activity by the driver or helper must be immediately reported to the local police**, and the driver will be disallowed from continuing the journey. In such cases, a **replacement driver must be provided without delay**.

- It will be the **responsibility of the bidder to ensure that drivers and helpers follow the orders and directions of the convoy commander** deputed by the Commandant/HOO, CWS/FAW-1, ITBP.
- Movement of the convoy shall be strictly as per the approved **move plan of the Unit**.

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer, is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1

bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

This Bid is governed by the General Terms and Conditions, conditions stipulated in Bid and Service Level Agreement specific to the Service, as the case may be, as provided in the Marketplace.

However, in case of Service, if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement specific to said Service, then it will over-ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.
