1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years at the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.

3. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference/price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which will be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

5. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost or
2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost or
3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost

6. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all with any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. 1. The bidder should have past experience of executing similar nature of work.
2. The experience certificate should be issued by officer not below the rank of XEN or equivalent.
3. Valid EPF, ESI, PAN No. & GST No. shall be submitted by bidder through online. The contractor will also have to show the original certificates of above said documents and enlistment certificates on demand.
4. As per policy for engaging / outsourcing of services / activities / guidelines for compliance of labour law conveyed by the Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana Letter No 43/5/2001-3GS-II dated 20-02-2001 and further reconsidered time to time by Govt. of Haryana, the service provider who offers services at a profit margin will not be given contract.
5. If any service provider is submitting a bid for less than the amounts (Minimum wage + EPF + ESI) besides his service charges, service tax and TDS (2%), then the bid will be liable to be rejected.
6. The bidder must quote premium more than 2% of estimated amount (As per Annex-D). If any bidder quotes premium below or equal to 2% of financial implication amount, then the bid will be liable to be rejected. The quoted premium will be considered only up to two digits after decimal point.
7. In case there are more than one L-1 bidders (lowest bidders) as per their quoted/ negotiated rates by bidders, a merit list of all the responsive bidders will be prepared on the basis of their average annual turn-over for the best three years out of last five years (certificate of registered Chartered accountant in respect of annual turn-over for last five years is to be provided by bidder) and preference will be given to bidder having highest average annual turn-over for the best three years out of last five years.
8. The minimum wage rates would be considered as per HKRNL wage rates notification no. HKRNL/Finan 683 dt. 12.09.2025 by the O/o General Manager (Finance) for Chief Executive Officer, HKRNL, Panchkula, Haryana and subsequent instructions issued thereafter.
9. BBMB reserves the right to reject any or all tenders/withdraw the invitation of bids without assigning a reason.

**SCOPE OF WORK**

1. The scope of work under this contract comprises outsourcing of housekeeping service (unskilled) at 400 KV Station Complex under Operation & Maintenance Circle, BBMB, Panipat all as detailed under:-

  - a). Sweeper shall perform the duties of 8 Hours duration from 08:00 AM to 05:00 PM with having 1 Hour from 12:00 Noon to 01:00 PM break on all working days or as directed by the office-in-charge.
  - b). The manpower provided by the contractor will be entitled to one weekly off, National Holiday etc. as per Labour Laws.
3. Including of manpower/personnel:- Manpower/Personnel provided by the contractor should know that politeness is expected to them in their relations with the office and should any case of incivility by proved against them contractor have to replace the Sweeper on priority base.
4. Qualification:-
  - a). Safai Sewak:- Should be literate, physically sound and mentally sound.
5. Responsibility of duties:-
  - a). Safai Sewak (Full time) against office contingency:- The personnel will work of sweeping, cleaning of offices, rest houses, control room, roads, berms, parks, sewerage etc. and dispose of garbage etc. in the premises of 400 KV Sub Station, BBMB, Panipat having this purpose area is about 1000 sq. metres.

The below terms shall be deemed to include the following responsibility for all duties entered in the contract by the officers under whom he is deployed:-

- i. Maintaining office space, compound, office rooms are neat and clean.
- ii. Maintaining cleaning of all ladies and gents toilets.
- iii. Sweeper attached to sections are responsible for cleanliness of rooms respective sections before office hours i.e. 09:00 AM on all working days.
- iv. The floor of every room of the office, corridors and varandas shall be thoroughly swept by the sweepers. The section in charge will also see that drains and latrines/lavatories are kept clean by them.
- v. Work material of daily routine of office shall be disposed off as per guideline Swachh Abhiyan.
- vi. Maintaining cleaning of all office tables & chairs and other furniture items etc.

6. Mode of payment:-

- a). Salaries and allied charges shall be paid to personnel deployed by contractor at BBMB, Panipat as per Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Rates. Wages will commence from the date of reporting to BBMB office Panipat.
- b). Rates as quoted by the contractor will not change under any circumstances during the contract period.
- c). Contractor shall send the authenticated signed Duty Certificate in respect of each worker by 1<sup>st</sup> of each month.
- d). Contractor will prepare the salary bill/invoice and submit to the officer-in-charge of BBMB on or before 5<sup>th</sup> of each month.
- e). The contractor shall disburse the wages to the workers through bank account on or before 7<sup>th</sup> of each month.
- f). BBMB shall make reimbursements of the wages based on the invoice revised by contractor within 10 working days of receipt of invoice and make the payment to contractor through DD/RTGS/FT etc. on monthly basis.
- g). The payment of EPF/ESI & other legal liabilities shall depend on the contractor. BBMB shall remain responsible for these liabilities.

7. Wages:-

- i. The provision of wages has been made as per Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Ltd. Letter No. HKRNL/Finance/1683 dt. 12.09.2025 (Monthly wages) (copy attached).
- ii. Analysis of rates regarding wage & other charges to be paid to contractor is attached.

8. Character verification:-

It is the duty of the contractor to certify that personnel/manpower provided by the contractor are of good moral character and have no criminal record and no departmental as well as judicial proceedings are pending against them earlier.

9. An agreement on Non-Judicial stamp papers for total value of Allotment order shall be executed between the contractor and the Department within 15 days from the issue of Allotment order or from the date commencement of work. On acceptance of the tender, the contractor shall either himself remain available at the site of work or arrange the availability of an accredited representative, fully authorized in writing, at the site of work to receive instructions of the Engineer-in-Charge or his representative and to ensure prompt compliance thereof.

10. CONTRACTOR LIABLE FOR PAYMENT OR COMPENSATION TO INJURED WORKMAN OR IN CASE OF DEATH :-

In every case in which by virtue of the provision of section 12, Sub-section (1) of the Workmen's Compensation Act 1922, the BBMB is obliged to pay compensation to a workman employed by the contractor in execution of

k, the BBMB will recover from the contractor the amount of compensation so paid and without prejudice to the rights of BBMB under section 12, sub section (ii) of the said Act. BBMB shall be at liberty to recover such amount in any part thereof by deducting it from the security deposit or from any sums due by the BBMB to the contractor whether under this contract or otherwise BBMB shall not be bound to contest any claim made against it under section 12, sub-section (1) of the said Act except on the written request of the contractor and upon his giving to BBMB full security for all costs for which BBMB might become liable in consequence of contesting such claim.

11. Arbitrations:-

In case of any dispute or difference arising out of the implementation or interpretation of any of the clauses of the contract, the same shall be settled as per the provisions of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act - 1996 and the matter will be referred to Sole Arbitrator appointed by mutual consent of both parties and in case of any party not agreeing for appointment of Sole Arbitrator, each party will nominate their own Arbitrators and these two arbitrators will further nominate one person to act as umpire of Arbitral Tribunal whose decision shall be final and binding on both parties.

12. Period of contract:-

The contract will be for one year and commence from 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2026 to 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2027.

13. The entire risk and responsibility regarding any type of accident/damage, death of workman etc. during performance of duties by manpower will lie with the contractor.

This Bid is governed by the [सामान्य नियम और शर्तें/General Terms and Conditions](#), conditions stipulated in Bid and [Service Level Agreement](#) specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace. However in case if any condition specified in सामान्य नियम और शर्तें/General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will override the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.
