Special terms and conditions-Version:2 effective from 21-08-2025 for category Surveillance Drone / Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (V2)

1. 1. This drone category pertains to drone complying to latest version of Drone Rules (notified by Ministry of Civil Aviation).
2. Catalogs are to be submitted with valid and active "Type Certificate" as per the aforementioned Drone Rules.
3. Seller shall issue a Certificate of Conformity for each UAS, stating responsibility of model confirmation to the issued Type Certificate and relevant data sheet.

1. **Generic**

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

3. **Turnover**

5. **OEM**

IMPORTED PRODUCTS: In case of imported products, OEM or Authorized Seller of OEM should have a registered office in India to provide after sales service support in India. The certificate to this effect should be submitted.

Dedicated /toll Free Telephone No. for Service Support : BIDDER/OEM must have Dedicated/toll Free Telephone No. for Service Support.

7. **Service & Support**

Escalation Matrix For Service Support : Bidder/OEM must provide Escalation Matrix of Telephone Numbers for Service Support.

8. **Inspection**

Nominated Inspection Agency: On behalf of the Buyer organization, any one of the following Inspection Agency would be conducting inspection of stores before acceptance:
Pre-dispatch Inspection at Seller Premises (applicable only if pre-dispatch inspection clause has been selected in ATC):

RITES or any other eligible NABL accredited agency after prior approval of buyer department.

Post Receipt Inspection at consignee site before acceptance of stores:
TUC/CIC of buyer department.

9. **Certificates**

ISO 9001: The bidder or the OEM of the offered products must have ISO 9001 certification.

10. **Certificates**

The bidder is required to upload, along with the bid, all relevant certificates such as BIS licence, type test certificate, approval certificates and other certificates as prescribed in the Product Specification given in the bid document.

11. **Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

12. **Warranty**

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 2 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

13. **Warranty**

Successful bidder will have to ensure that adequate number of dedicated technical service personals / engineers are designated / deployed for attending to the Service Request in a time bound manner and for ensuring Timely Servicing / rectification of defects during warranty period, as per Service level agreement indicated in the relevant clause of the bid.

14. **Warranty**

Timely Servicing / rectification of defects during warranty period: After having been notified of the defects / service requirement during warranty period, Seller has to complete the required Service / Rectification within 7 days time limit. If the Seller fails to complete service / rectification with defined time limit, a penalty of 0.5% of Unit Price of the product shall be charged as penalty for each week of delay from the seller. Seller can deposit the penalty with the Buyer directly else the Buyer shall have a right to recover all such penalty amount from the Performance Security (PBG). Cumulative Penalty cannot exceed more than 10% of the total contract value after which the Buyer shall have the right to get the service / rectification done from alternate sources at the risk and cost of the Seller besides forfeiture of PBG. Seller shall be liable to re-imburse the cost of such service / rectification to the Buyer.

15. **Financial Criteria**

NET WORTH: Net Worth of the OEM should be positive as per the last audited financial statement.

16. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

- (i) **Pre-dispatch inspection (Interim and Final) at Seller premises (Fee/ Charges to be borne by the SELLER):** Before dispatch, the goods will be inspected by Buyer/Consignee or their Authorized Representative or by Nominated External Inspection Agency (Independently in presence of the Buyer or Consignee as decided by the Buyer Department) at Seller premises for their compliance to the contract specifications.

In pre-dispatch inspection Technical-cum-User Committee (TUC)/ Central Inspection Committee (CIC) of Buyer organization will also be participating as a witness. Fees/Charges taken by the external inspection Agency and any external laboratories testing charges shall be borne by the Seller.

The goods would be dispatched to consignee only after clearance in pre-dispatch inspection. Consignee's right of rejection as per GTC in respect of the goods finally received at his location shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the goods having previously been inspected, tested and passed by Buyer/Consignee or its Nominated External Inspection Agency prior to the goods' shipment. While bidding, the sellers should take into account 7 days for inspection from the date of email offering the goods for inspection. Any delay in inspection beyond 7 days shall be on the part of the buyer and shall be regularized without Liquidated Damages. Inspection and external laboratory testing charges shall be borne by the supplier and it shall not be reimbursed by Buyer to them at any point in time. Cost of inspection/testing shall be factored in by the supplier in the cost of the product itself while submitting bid.

- (iii) The bidder as well as their principal OEM/OEM associate firms are not blacklisted or Debarred by any Government or Public Sector Undertaking or Corporation in India at the time of bidding.
- (iv) The firm participating in the tender shall certify in writing that they have accepted the ATC/GTC criteria of the tender.
- (v) Maximum Operating Temperature up to 200° C.
 - (vi) Maximum Payload Weight-500 gm.
 - (vii) DRI (Detection, Recognition and Identification)-Human, Vehicle and Fire Sources.
