1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or

similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

3. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. 4. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) from the State of Bid Inviting Authority : Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as Micro and Small Enterprises from the State of Bid inviting Authority. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity ÷ Original quantity) × Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery

period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION FOR STEEL TUBULAR POLES AGAINST KESCo-GeM-TENDER NO. 03/2026-27

- 1.1 The Steel Tubular Poles shall conform to IS: 2713 (Part I - III) 1980 and latest amendments thereof in every respect. The inspecting team of Engineers of KESCo, Kanpur will carry out the following tests as prescribed in the above ISS
- (a) Verification of dimensions and weight.
 - (b) Deflection test.
 - (c) Permanent Set Test.
 - (d) Drop Test.
- 1.2 The Tolerances on the dimensions shall be as per above ISS however no tolerance will be allowed on weight. Any addition/Deletion in the list of above tests shall be made as per IS: 2713 (Part I to III) and latest amendments thereof.
- 1.3 Poles shall be made of Steel Tubes having minimum tensile strength 42Kg. per sq. mm., minimum yield stress and minimum percentage elongation as specified in IS: 1161-1998 and latest amendments thereof. The H. R. strip coil Grade-III by which these tubes are made should be conforming to IS: 3995 and latest amendments thereof. The pole shall be made in 3 sections of dimensions as specified in technical particulars annexed herewith. The tubes should be swaged jointed to form poles to give a strong joint, which shall withstand all the tests as per ISS without any circumferential welding. The circumferential welding is only to be done after carrying out all the tests. No circumferential joints shall be permitted in the individual tube length of poles. The poles shall be coated with bituminous paint internally and externally up to the level which goes inside the earth and remaining portion of exterior shall be painted with one coat of red oxide primer as specified in IS: 2713-1980 (Part I-III) read with IS: 2074-1979 and latest amendments thereof. A through hole of 14mm diameter shall be provided in each pole at a height of 300 mm above the planting depth. Convex shape top cover of 3 mm thick M.S. plate duly tack welded to be provided.
- 1.4 **MARKING OF POLES**
The supplier will engrave/paint by Stencil on each pole the code number which will be intimate at the time of placing the order. The suppliers will also engrave/paint by Stencil on each pole: - (KESCo Manufacturer's Name/Year of manufacturing)
- 1.5 **WARRANTY:** The materials supplied against this specification shall be backed up by manufacturer's guarantee for a period of 36 months from the date of commissioning or 42 months from the completion of supply whichever is earlier, against defective design, and material.
- 1.6 **TESTING / INSPECTION:**
- (i) The testing of these poles shall be performed as per procedures contained in Clause-10 of ISS: 2713 (Part-I)-1980. **No negative tolerance will be allowed.**
 - (ii) Number of poles selected for conducting deflection test, permanent set test, drop test specified in Clause-10.1 of ISS: 2713 (Para-I-1998) shall be as follows :-

(iii) After successful testing/inspection of the poles offered for inspection, the inspection team will dispatch authorization with the conditions that the supplier shall ensure welding, denting, painting, numbering and capping of all the poles of whole lot offered for inspection (including those not inspected by the inspection team.) The supplier, after successful testing/inspection of the poles offered for inspection shall get all the poles weighed by weighing of carrier before and after loading of poles with "AM KANTA" and send the original receipt of the weighment to the concerned store Centre so that the weight of the pole could be ascertained and verified by consignee.

- (iv) The supplier shall provide following documents at the time of inspection & testing of material:
- Photocopy of Challan/Invoices along with manufacturer's test certificates of raw materials (Tubes as per IS: 1161-1998 and latest amendments thereof) provided by supplier for manufacturing of lot of material offered for inspection.
 - Photocopy of manufacturer's test certificates along with relevant Challan/Invoices issued by the firm supplying the raw materials i.e. H. R. Coils Grade-III (HR coils as per IS: 10748-1998 and latest amendments thereof) to the supplier for manufacture of lot of material offered for inspection.
 - Photocopy of "Calibration Certificate" in respect of instruments used at the time of testing of material.

The inspecting officers shall verify all above photocopies of the documents from original documents and submit the same to Superintending Engineer (MM) after signing each document, along with the test report/D.A.

For Quality Control: - The firm Shall accept challenge testing and acceptance shall be enclosed in writing

- a. The label contents can be challenged by any person.
- b. The challenge must be submitted to KESCO in writing.
- c. KESCO will examine the challenge within a month of the date of receipt in writing. The Standards and Labeling Implementation Committee will recon whether to conduct a challenge test or not, keeping in view the basis of the complaint and examination of past records.
- d. The decision of KESCO will be final and will be conveyed to complainant along with just

ification.

- e. If a challenge test is required then
 - i. The complainant will deposit the expenses related to transportation (to and from the place of picking of sample to the test laboratory) and testing in advance to KESCO.
 - ii. KESCO will arrange for selection and sealing of samples. The transportation to the assigned laboratory is the task of the user of label.
 - iii. The testing will be conducted in an independent Test laboratory registered with KESCO and the testing charges would be paid out of the advance by the complainant.
- f. The complainant and the user of label may witness the process of challenge testing.
- g. If the equipment fails the challenge test, then the expenses paid by the complainant would be reimbursed by the user of label whose equipment has failed.
- h. If the equipment passes the challenge test, then the deposit of complainant would be forfeited.
- i. If the equipment fails the challenge test the enforcement process (section) will be followed.

B) Enforcement Process

- a. If the equipment fails the verification/challenge testing, then the matter will be placed before the Standards and labeling Implementation Committee and the user of label will be informed about the failure.
 - b. The user of label has the option to go in for the second test, in case the equipment fails the first verification/challenge test
 - c. A second test will be carried on with twice the initial test sample size, and all the samples should pass the test.
 - d. The user of label will bear the expenses related to the second test.
 - e. If the equipment passes the second verification/challenge test then no further action would be taken and the appliance would deem to confirm to the label.

 - g. If the user of label fails to comply with the direction issued under clause (f) the use of label for that model will be prohibited. In addition,
 - i. KESCO will inform the consumers about the failure of the equipment by wide publicity.

Sample Testing and max. damage/failure rate:

- The Kesco will reserve the right of inspection of supplied material (randomly selected samples) by any third-party agency (Like CPRI, ERDA etc.). Discom will also issue notices to the material manufacturer to depute their nominee to be present at the time of sealing of the selected sample, failing which the sample will be selected & sealed in presence of Discom team, only. - If sample of Material fails/not found as per specification in the testing as above, the Kesco will be free to take action against the firm as per rules/ guidelines issued by the UPPCL.
