- 1) The tenderers shall submit a copy of certificate stating that all their statements/documents submitted along with the bid are true and factual. Standard format of the certificate to be submitted by the bidder is enclosed as **Annexure-K**. Non submission of the above certificate by the bidder shall result in **summarily rejection** of his/their bid. It shall be mandatorily incumbent upon the tenderer to identify state and submit the supporting documents duly self-attested by which they/he is qualifying the Qualifying Criteria mentioned in the Tender Document.
- 2) The bidders shall submit the documents required as per the checklist along with the bid.

 - 6) If any discrepancies/contradictions happen between SLA and GCC, then GCC Services shall prevail.
 - 7) The maintenance location may change during Contract period in view of operational requirement of Railways.
 - 8) The arising shown in Price Schedule is purely approximate and the actual may vary.
 - 9) The amount will be paid for the actual work carried out during the Contract
 - 10) Tender conditions/other particulars are available in the Tender documents uploaded along with the Tender Notice on our website at **http:// www.gem.gov.in**
 - 11) EMD: The bidders will have to make payment towards **earnest money** against such tenders through online payment modes like **net banking, debit/ credit cards etc. available on Gem portal**. If the possibility of net banking, debit/credit cards etc. is not available then the bidder can submit EMD in form of **DD/FDR etc., in favour of Sr.DFM/HYB, 1st Floor, Hyderabad Bhavan, Secunderabad** before the date of tender opening to the office of **Sr.DME/Diesel/Moula-Ali** without which the tender will be **summarily rejected**.
 - 12) Tender document cost is zero.

The bidders are advised to thoroughly go through the document before submitting their bid along with the format.
 - 15) Tender conditions/other particulars are available in the Tender documents **uploaded along with the Tender Notice** on our website at **http:// www.gem.gov.in**
 - 16) The prospective bidders are advised to visit website **https://www. gem.gov.in** seven days before the date of tender opening to note any changes/corrigenda for any tender.
 - 17) Before submitting the bid the bidder to satisfy himself for having eligibility criteria as mentioned in the tender schedule and provide the relevant documents in support of it. The bid is liable to be rejected on uploading of irrelevant documents.
 - 18) If the contractor desires to visit the work-site before bidding, he may do so with prior permission from Sr.DME/DSL/MLY.

- 22) Railway reserves the right to cancel the tender without assigning any reason thereto.
- 23) The administration will not own any responsibility, if website is not opened for downloading/uploading the tender documents due to any technical snag.
- 24) The tenderers shall submit a copy of **certificate** stating that all their statements/documents submitted along with the bid are true and factual. Work Experience- The bidder should have satisfactorily completed* in the last three previous financial years and the current financial year up to the date of opening of the tender, one similar single service contract** for a minimum of 35% of advertised value of the bid.

**Completed service contract includes on-going service contract subject to payment of bills amounting to at least 35% of the advertised value of the bid.

Similar nature of work approved vide CEE/SCR letter no. E.252.TRS/Contract Policy. VIII/2008 dated 04.11.2013 is furnished below.

****Similar nature of work means “Transportation of heavy electrical equipment’s viz., transformers, motors, reactors, rectifiers or heavy mechanical equipment viz., loco bogies, steel / iron ingots or similar finished/semi-finished iron/steel products weighing more than 5 tones etc., by 9 tons / 16 tons lorries across various states of India.”**

Notes:

- 4.** The total value of similar nature of works completed/on-going during the qualifying period, and not the payments received within qualifying period alone, shall be considered.
- 5.** In case, the final bill of similar nature of work has not been passed and final measurements have not been recorded, the paid amount including Statutory deductions will be considered.
- 6.** If final measurements have been recorded and work has not been completed with negative variation, then also the paid amount including statutory deductions will be considered.
- 7.** However, if final measurements have been recorded and work has been completed with positive variation but variation has not been sanctioned , original agreement value or last sanctioned agreement value whichever is lower shall be considered for judging eligibility.
- 8.** In case of composite works involving combination of different works, even separately completed works of required value should be considered while evaluating the eligibility criteria.

If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

This Bid is governed by the General Terms and Conditions, conditions stipulated in Bid and Service Level Agreement specific to the Service, as the case may be, as provided in the Marketplace.
