This Bid provides for Trade Receivables Discounting System (TReDS) as Preferred mode of payment. For MSME sellers, payments may be processed through a TReDS exchange in which the Buyer is registered, subject to applicable policy and regulatory guidelines. 1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. 2. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.
3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
4. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -
 1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
 2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
 3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.

3. **Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITION

The scope of services and terms & conditions for hiring the D.G. Set are as under:

1. The terms and conditions along with the instructions will form part of the tender to be submitted by the tenderer to LIC of India, herein termed as Corporation.
2. The offer should remain valid at least for a period of 45 (forty five) days to be reckoned from the date of opening of "Financial Bid".
3. There should not be any deviation in terms and conditions as have been stipulated in the tender documents. However, in the event of imposition of any other condition, which may lead to a deviation with respect to the terms and conditions as mentioned in the tender documents, the vendor is required to attach a separate sheet marking "list of deviations".
4. Canvassing in any form will disqualify the tenderer.
5. Income-Tax and Statutory clearances if any is required shall be obtained by the vendors at their own cost. As and when required. All payments to the successful vendor shall be made by NEFT / R TGS only.

6. The financial bids will be opened only if at least Two Technical Bids are found suitable. In any case single Financial Bid shall not be opened.
7. Rates are to be quoted for running the D.G.Set monthly including rental charges as per Schedule of Quantity for each rating of D.G. Set complete with all accessories on hire basis and DG set operation charges.
8. The vendor will provide valid ID and address proof of the operator. The operator provided by the supplier, should possess the requisite & valid electrical License, for running D.G.Set.
9. All cost for maintenance and servicing of the generator including the cost of spare parts and periodical replacement of Mobil oil are to be borne by the D.G.set contractor.
10. The D.G. Sets should be maintained properly to keep those in satisfactory running condition at all times for supplying emergency power for a load at least 90% of rated output of respective generators.
11. The permission of statutory authorities towards installation of D.G. Sets will be obtained by the supplier of D.G. Set at their cost.
12. The arrangements for providing accessories like cables, change-over switches etc., if required will be made by the contractor at their own cost.
13. The arrangements for providing exhaust pipeline of the D.G. Set, as per requirement & specification of Statutory Authorities, will be made by the contractor at their own cost.
14. Mending of any damage caused to the LIC property during loading, unloading of the D.G. Set in LIC premises at the time of installation or taking out D.G set from LIC premises will be done by the contractor to original finish, at their cost.
15. The successful bidder should install and commission the D.G. Set in LIC premises within 45 (Forty five) days from the date of awarding the contract.
16. Electricity Duty, if any, payable to the State Govt., depending on running hours of the D.G. Set shall be borne by the contractor. Installation of the energy meter with its calibration and registration with the Statutory Authority shall be done by the contractor at their cost.
17. Validity of Contract - The contract shall remain in force initially for a period of three years from the date of installation and satisfactory commissioning of the D.G. Set at site. However, the contract is subject to termination at any time if the services are not found satisfactory or for any other reason whatsoever by serving three calendar months notice on either side. Also LIC of India can terminate the contract by serving three calendar months notice if the services of DG set are not required. The contract may be renewed for further period at mutually agreed rates / charges and keeping other terms & conditions unchanged, depending on satisfactory services rendered by the generator supplier and requirement of the office.
18. In case of any major break-down of D.G. Sets requiring repairing time for more than one day, an alternative interim arrangement will be made by the generator provider immediately by providing a substitute generator of adequate capacity at no extra cost.

For non-functioning of the D.G. Set or in the event of failure on the part of the generator supplier to provide an alternative interim generator of adequate capacity, within one day during power failure / Load shedding, penalty deduction shall be made based on OT rate for running of DG set beyond normal hours and if the same is not restored within 24 hours, corporation will be free to hire another DG set from the market at the risk and cost of contractor limited to double the amount quoted by the contractor.

19. Tenders should be submitted along with the requisite Earnest Money Deposit amount in the prescribed mode. Tenders submitted without Earnest Money Deposit will be summarily rejected. The Earnest Money will not bear any interest. (provide NEFT / RTGS details along with suitable Annexure B)
20. The successful bidder will also have to remit performance Security Deposit by NEFT/DD /Pay Order / Banker's Cheque for an amount equal to 3 % of accepted tender amount of a year within 15 days from the date of issue of acceptance letter. Work order for commencement of the work will be issued separately within seven days after the contractor remit the requisite performance Security De

posit. If the successful bidder agrees to convert the EMD amount to Security Deposit , in that case the contractor shall have to deposit an amount equal to 3% of accepted tender of a year less EMD amount deposited along with the tender within 15 days from the date of issue of acceptance letter. Please note that the Security Deposit

will not bear any interest and the same will be refunded to the contractor within 45 (Forty five) days after the closure of the contract.

21. The successful bidder will have to execute an Agreement with the LIC of India, on Non - judicial stamp paper of requisite value and as per the draft of Agreement to be provided by the LIC of India , within 14 (Fourteen) days from the date of issue of work order for commencement of the work. No payment will be made until the Agreement is executed. Please note that necessary instructions for payment will be issued to concerned Divisional / Branch Office only after execution of agreement.
22. In case the successful bidder remit the full amount of Security Deposit (i.e. 3 % of Estimated annual rent of a year by NEFT/ DD / Pay Order / Banker's Cheque) in that case their EMD amount will be refunded after execution of the Agreement.
23. The deployment of operator for running the generator should comply with the Labour Legislation Act. and Minimum wage Act of Govt. of India and the State Govt.
24. The contractor will have to remove the D.G. Set from the LIC premises within 07 (Seven) days from the date of termination or closure of the contract at their cost , else demurrage charges @ 1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) per day will be levied by the LIC of India, on the contractor.
25. The D.G. set shall have to be run in the event of load shedding / power cut / breakdown (Internal or External) / single phasing / erratic power supply from supply Co. on all working days.
 - v Normal working hours on all working days shall be From Monday to Friday - 9.30 AM to 6.30 PM.
 - v The DG set running hours during working hours shall be 156 hours annually (approximately) based on previous year's power cut during working hours. (Kindly note that given running hours are indicative only, it could increase or decrease in any scenario. No Overtime for running DG set shall be given during normal working hours on all working days in any case.)
26. Please note that DG set shall comprise Diesel Engine of Kirloskar Green / Cummins India/ greaves/ Mahindra & Mahindra Ltd./ Ashok Leyland coupled with air / water cooled Alternator of Stamford / Crompton / Kirloskar, O.E.Ms ie Jakson / Bhaskar with AMF Panel along with Remote Monitoring Tracking will only be accepted. If at any stage it is found that DG set provided is not of our approved make, LIC reserves the right to ask the contractor to remove the DG set & provide new DG set as per approved makes.
27. The successful tenderer has to submit copies of invoices after procurement of D.G.Set the name, address & phone no. of service centre shall also be mentioned.
28. Hiring charges shall be payable from the date of commissioning / date of energizing the electrical installation.
29. The quoted rate for running the D.G set on monthly hire basis shall be inclusive of cost of DG set installation, operation (including operator) , cost of diesel price prevailing in the market at the date of opening of tender, lubricant, maintenance, tools, security etc. complete required for DG set operation. Please note that any variation (Increases / Decreases) in the price of diesel will be considered for payment / recovery as per the Govt. notification issued for diesel price.
30. Price adjustment for the cost of running of DG set due to variation in diesel price- Price adjustment shall be done on the basis of actual consumption of diesel for operation of DG in a given period. For further details kindly refer point no 4 of Special Condition.
31. GST is not payable on Diesel difference. Two separate bills shall be submitted by the vendor, one is for Monthly rental and one is for diesel difference. GST is only payable on monthly rental.
32. A Log book shall be maintained for recording the daily running of DG set. including over time which

h should be signed by authorized representative of LIC on daily basis.

33. Bill shall be submitted in triplicate in the first week of the following month along with the Xerox copy of Logbook and original Log Book for certification and settlement of the bill. The payment will be made after deducting the Income Tax and Works contract Tax etc. at source as per the rules from the running bills. No payment will be made until the Agreement is executed.
34. If required Tenderer has to submit necessary approval from pollution control board / Directorate of electrical safety without any extra cost to LIC. Sound and pollution level shall be maintained within the prescribed limits.
35. Successful tenderer has to obtain policies to cover T.P., Fire and W.C. Insurance cover of suitable amount for each policy (as mentioned in LOI / Acceptance letter) which shall remain in force till the contract, period and extension if granted. No payment shall be released, if the insurance lapses during contract period. "Penalty of not taking timely extension of expired policies - The date of submitting the renewed insurance policy, if any will be 15 working days prior to the last date of expiry of the existing policy, failing which LIC may insure/renew insurance and apply penal cost on the contractor i.e. Premium Charges plus Rs. 10,000/- as Admin Charges and Rs. 25,000/- as penalty."
36. Tenderers are requested to visit to the site of work before quoting their rates.
37. The essential service electrical load (including AC) shall be connected to D. G. set.
38. Agency has to arrange suitable foundation, earthing with copper earth plate and suitable size cable up to changeover switch provided in panel etc., as per relevant IS - Code, as under, which has to be certified / confirmed by the LIC Engineer. Nothing extra shall be paid in this regard. (Kindly refer Annexure 'C')
 - a- Separate earth shall be provided for Genset Body and Neutral earthing b- 02 nos. Earthing Pits are required for 1 Phase DG set and 3 Phase DG set upto 30 KVA DG set, 01 each for neutral & earthing.
 - c- 03 nos. Earthing Pits are required for 40-125 Kva DG set, 1 for Neutral & 2 for Body.
 - d- 04 nos. Earthing pit are required for 160 KVA & above DG set, 2 each for Neutral & Body
39. Unauthorized supply of power to other agency / firms from the D.G.set installed at our premises, if any are found, penal action of immediate termination of contract with forfeiture of Security Deposit will be taken against the vendor.
40. LIC shall not be responsible for any injury partial or permanent or death of any worker at site due to accident or any other reasons or by personal negligence of the staff of the contractor. LIC of India, will remain indemnified by the contractor on this account.
41. The firm shall be fully responsible for any liability / compensation in case of any accident or otherwise any untoward incident at his own risk for the staff deputed by the firm and LIC shall not give any compensation.
42. First Aid box shall be arranged by the contractor at site of work at their cost.
43. Timing may change according to the LIC's requirement.
44. The contractor shall not sublet the contract to any other party / contractor.

45. Contractor shall be solely responsible for payment of wages / salaries and allowances to his personnel that might become applicable under any Government order. LIC of India shall have no liability whatsoever in any manner.
46. For running the generator beyond the schedule hours, permission in writing shall be taken from the LIC of India and a copy of the same shall be produced while claiming the overtime charges.
47. LIC will provide suitable space for installation of D.G.set but other infrastructures to be arranged by the vendor.
48. Report of the following tests performed at manufacture's outlet prior to packing & dispatch to site shall be submitted by the vendor:-
 - a- Load test at full load 50% load, 75% and 110% overload.
 - b- Fuel consumption at full load, 75% load, 50% load and 25% load.
 - c- Other routine test as per IS / BS on alternator, exciter and AVR. Original copies of the test certificates shall be submitted to LIC of India. (d) Noise level measurement.
49. In case of dispute, the matter shall be settled mutually, failing which the decision of the Sr. Divisional manager, LIC of India, shall be final and binding on the bidders.
50. LIC of India, reserves the right to accept any tender or to reject any or all tenders at his sole discretion without assigning reasons whatsoever. The tender inviting authority does not bind to accept the lowest tender.

Special condition

The scope of services and terms & conditions for hiring the D.G. Set are as subject the following Special conditions.

1. If Agency fails to install DG set within 45 Days from the Date of LOI, contractor will be debarred for the period of minimum 3 years and same may be conveyed to all the Zonal offices of LIC of India and all Divisional offices under the NCZO. In addition EMD / SD/ Performance Guarantee deposited shall be forfeited.

2. If at any stage it is found that DG set provided is not of our approved make/ or old DG set have been provided, LIC reserves the right to ask the contractor to remove the DG set & provide new DG set as per tender condition. If contractor fails to comply the Tender specifications / tender conditions, accepted Hiring charges shall be reduced @ 25% and contract may be terminated by giving three months notice and performance guarantee deposited may also be forfeited.

3. Penalty due to non operation of DG set: If DG set is not operated due to unavailability of operator / or diesel is not provided penalty as under subject to the max. of monthly rent shall be deducted.

a- 125 KVA DG set - Rs. 1000.00 each occasion
 b- 100 KVA DG set - Rs. 750.00 each occasion
 c- 82.5 KVA DG set - Rs.700 .00 each occasion
 d- 62.5 KVA DG set - Rs.650.00 each occasion

e- 25/30 KVA DG set - Rs. 250.00 each occasion

If incident of non operation of DG set is occurring frequently, contract will be terminated by giving one

month notice and SD / performance guarantee deposited shall be forfeited and agency will be debarred for min. 3 years for participating in tenders for the subject work.

4. Price adjustment for the cost of running of DG set due to variation in diesel price- For the purpose of payment in account of Diesel Price Variation fuel consumption will be considered as per actual fuel consumption based on the reports generated through the remote monitoring system installed with proposed DG set subject to maximum as per manufacturer fuel consumption chart. If remote monitoring system is not provided with the DG set and diesel price variation bill is not supported with the auto generated report / report obtained from remote monitoring software, no price variation in account of Diesel price variation shall be paid.

Prevailing Diesel Price - Rs.87.81 per liter. (Rupees Eighty Seven and paisa eighty one only per liter) is considered for fixing the hiring charges.

5. A Log book shall be maintained for recording the daily running of DG set including over time (In comparison with the daily Hour meter reading of DG set panel too) which should be signed by authorized representative of LIC on each day of DG set running. Detailed report from the remote monitoring system shall also be attached for various parameters as detailed in SOQ. Also the provision for access of Remote monitoring shall be provided to L.I.C authorized representative for continuous monitoring of D.G. Set parameter at our end

6. The rate quoted to include all taxes as applicable excluding Goods and Service Tax. The taxes at sources shall be deducted as per rules stipulated by Government / Finance Act etc. Goods and Service Tax will be paid separately along with bill payment as per applicable rate of GST at the time of settlement of the bill.

7. Insurance policies - Successful tenderer has to obtain policies to cover Third Party., Fire and Workmen compensation Insurance cover of suitable amount for each policy which shall remain in force till the contract, period and extension if granted. No payment shall be

released, if the insurance lapses during contract period

RECOVERY FOR NON EXTENSION OF INSURANCE POLICIES:-In default of the Contractor insuring as provided above, or having insured, failing to renew the same, as required, the Employer, on his behalf may so insure/renew and may deduct the premiums paid from any monies due or which may become due to the Contractor together with penalty amounting to Rs.10,000/- or double the premium amount whichever ever is more, for each extension of such policy.

8. Recovery due to non provision of earthing & change over switch etc. - If contractor fails to provide earthing / change over cable etc. cost of the same subject to the max. 15% of one year accepted rent shall be recovered.

9. OT Operation of DG set - Permission in writing shall be taken from the LIC of India and a copy of the same shall be produced while claiming the overtime charges supported with the reports generated through the remote monitoring system.

Exhaust piping needs to be done to ensure that exhaust gases are guided out of the D.G.Set room without any leakage inside to ensure proper temperature in the room and or meet pollution board requirements. It is recommended to have class 'A' M.S. pipe or a fabricated pipe to minimize overall pipeline weight.

Generally exhaust piping should be designed such, so that backpressure for total system does not exceed 3 inches of mercury.

- a. Minimum bends (max.4 from exhaust magnified) should be there in pipeline.
- b. Exhaust pipe must be supported securely.
- c. Exhaust pipe inside the room should be lagged with asbestos rope/glass wool, aluminium sheet cladding.
- d. Pipeline should be away from combustible material.
- e. The orientation of Exhaust pipe shall be towards the normal wind direction.
- f. Rain cap should be provided.
- g. Flanges should be used for connecting flexible pipe, silencer etc. & asbestos sheet; gasket packing should be used in between the flanges.
- h. Silencer should be located in the exhaust line with necessary supports either within the D.G. Set room in horizontal position or vertically along the outside wall of D. G. Set room.
- i. Common exhaust pipe for multiple D.G. Set shall not be allowed.
- j. Exhaust pipe size shall be as recommended by the D. G. Set Manufacturer.
