2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the "Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 6. 8. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by the Government of India and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the preference, they should upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the product is manufactured, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or Chartered Accountant for other companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. 9. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by the Government of India and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the preference, they should upload a certificate from the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of the offered Service, the Bidder or its OEM (Service provider of the offered Service). Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid. The Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bids. If the Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band, the Seller (s) will be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total bid value. 10. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidder. It will have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quote submitted by the bidder based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

11. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar products to any Central / State Govt Organization / Public Enterprise (P.E.) (minimum cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

12. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of bid value.
