5. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.

6. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

7. Short Duration Bid has been published by the Buyer with the approval of the Competent authority due to Emergency procurement of critical products/services.

##### 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

##### 2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

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#### **ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR GeM HIRING CONTRACT**

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1. **Delivery Period:** - The goods are to be delivered to the consignee unit within the time limit that would be necessary for the vehicle to cover the distance at the rate of 350 Kms per day for trucks and 250 Kms for trailers except for reasons beyond the control of the carrier. Vendor should have the capability to position the trailer within 12 hours from placing of supply order. Failing to that Rs 500/- per day penalty]

would be deducted from PBG/bills/forthcoming bills.

**Illustration:** Assuming the distance between Delhi and Avadi (Chennai) to be 2135 Kms, a 6 Ton truck loaded at Delhi on 01 Apr 2022, must cover a minimum of 350 Kms per day from 02 Apr 2022 and report at AF Stn Avadi (Chennai) on 07 Apr 2022, to be off-loaded on next working day. The day of loading (at Delhi) and off-loading (at Avadi) are not considered. All days from Monday to Friday are considered as working days (excluding Govt holidays)

2. **Effective Date of the Contract:** -

The contract shall come into

effect on the date of placing supply order in GeM portal or the effective date mentioned in the Supply order whichever is earlier and shall remain valid until the completion of the obligations of the parties under the GeM contract. The deliveries and supplies and performance of the service shall commence from the effective date of contract.

3. **Liquidated Damages:-** In the event of the Seller's failure to supply the stores/goods/services as specified in this contract, the Buyer may, at his discretion, withhold any payment until the completion of the contract. The buyer may also deduct from the Seller as agreed, liquidated damages to the sum of 0.5 % of the contract price of the delayed/undelivered stores/ services mentioned above for every week of delay or part of a week, subject to the maximum value of the Liquidated Damages being not higher than 10% of the value of delayed services. This is applicable for delay in both placement of truck/ trailer and delay in reaching consignee, beyond stipulated period. This is exclusive of the occurrence of delay in positioning of desired transport beyond 48 hrs from the date and time specified in the supply order. Penalty will be leviable from the transporter @ 500/- per day which will be deducted from the outstanding bill. Waiver of LD will be at the discretion of buyer based on request for waiver given by the seller, with justification.

4. **Responsibility for Damage in Transit:** - The Bidder shall bear all responsibility and liability for any loss, damage, or destruction to the consignment from the point of dispatch until acceptance by the Purchaser/Consignee. This includes, but is not limited to, all costs, expenses, and efforts required for the physical recovery, repair, or replacement of any damaged goods. Such costs shall be determined and quantified by the Purchaser/Consignee and shall be borne in full by the Bidder without recourse.

5. **Compensation of Damages :-** The transporters will exercise all reasonable care and precautions in the conveyance and handling of stores (including Trans-shipment, if necessary). **He will be liable to compensate the Air Force as per Sec 12 of Carriage of road rules 2011.**

6. **Staggered delivery in case of multiple vehicles: -** In the event of multiple vehicles, that is more than one vehicle is required against the same supply order, the buyer may, at his discretion, can order staggered delivery of vehicles as per requirement within the contract period. Demand will be intimated 24 hrs in advance in normal cases. However in event of emergency, which will be on exceptional cases only, the contractor will have to position the vehicle within 06 hrs. Orders placed by contract operating officer through telephone/SM S/e-mail along with written supply orders are to be honoured.

7. **Trans-shipment/ Route diversion: -** **Trans-shipment of goods/vehicles en route is not permitted.** If inevitable due to emergency conditions prior approval of Buyer is to be acquired. Any loss or damage occurring on account of trans-shipment to new vehicle will be borne by the Seller only. Route diversion if any is to be done with prior consent of Buyer.

8. **Loading/Unloading:-** Loading at the starting point and Unloading of the vehicle at the destination will be the responsibility of the Air Force. Necessary manpower and handling equipment will be provided by the Air Force as required. **However, covering/lashing materials such as rope, tarpaulin, chains etc. are to be provided by the contractor.**

9. **Lashing/Covering of Trucks after Loading: -** Contractor shall supply only civil trucks covered with standard tarpaulin so as to avoid any deterioration of the Air Force stores, dispatched by truck. Any deterioration/damage to stores during transit due to improper lashing/covering would be sole responsibility of the transporter and he is liable to make good the loss, if any. Transporter is to ensure that none of the consignment is visible from outside when exiting from unit and up to entry into consignee unit.

10. **Octroi Duty,Local Taxes/Toll/Fastag /ODC Challan Payment:-** No additional payment will be admissible on account of Toll tax, ODC challan, Halts, Breakdown, Weather conditions etc. to the vendor.
