**This Bid provides for Trade Receivables Discounting System (TReDS) as Preferred mode of payment. For MSME sellers, payments may be processed through a TReDS exchange in which the Buyer is registered, subject to applicable policy and regulatory guidelines. Accordingly, sellers intending to avail payment through TReDS are required to be registered with at least one TReDS exchange in which the buyer is registered.**

1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023.

2. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

3. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
- v. If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

If the buyer has mentioned MSE purchase preference in ATC then service provider is required to upload necessary documents for MSE purchase preference for verification by the buyer during evaluation.

##### 1. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods

##### 2. Generic

Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.

##### 3. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be  $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$ , subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

##### 4. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

The requirement is for the supply of Propane-rich Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) in Jumbo LPG cylinders (each cylinder of capacity 425Kg/ 422Kg). The Total requirement is 42,500 Kg ie., Total 100 numbers of Jumbo LPG Gas Cylinders, each of Capacity 425 Kg/ 422 Kg will be required during the scheduled revival of Blast Furnace-IV (BF-IV) of SAIL-RSP.

**The bidders are required to quote “ per Kg” basis.**

### **I. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

SAIL-RSP registered vendors who are invited against this bid (or their authorized dealers) are only eligible to participate.

The bids submitted by the Sellers to whom Limited Tender Enquiry (LTE) has been issued (as above), shall only be considered for evaluation; bids from any other bidders shall be treated as unsolicited in the instant procurement case. However, the firms interested to be registered as a supplier for the tendered items to SAIL, should fill up the vendor registration form, hosted on SAIL Tenders website ([www.sailtenders.co.in](http://www.sailtenders.co.in)) and complete the due process of registration with SAIL Plants/Units.

\* This information is solely for the purpose of exploring the possibility of enhancing the vendor base, wherever required and should not be considered as a purchase enquiry. Purchase enquiry in future may be issued to such suppliers, if registered.

### **II. SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. Supplier shall be informed in advance regarding the tentative requirement of 425 Kg/ 422 Kg LPG cylinders at SAIL-Rourkela Steel Plant (RSP) to enable necessary logistics planning.
2. Factory-sealed, full Jumbo LPG cylinders shall be delivered as per SAIL-RSP's requirement at BF-IV site or any other location within RSP as instructed. Empty cylinders, after consumption, shall be collected by the Supplier at their own arrangement and cost. Requirement of Scissor Lift & Hand pallet trolley will be arranged by RSP.
3. Quantity Certification: Gross Weight of Truck with full cylinders = (Tare weight of cylinders + Tare weight of Truck). Supplier shall enclose the list of Tare Weight of each cylinder in every consignment.
4. Weighment of SAIL-RSP weigh bridge shall be final and binding on the supplier.
5. LPG cylinders shall be used in a manifold system consisting of two (2) banks of nine (9) cylinders each at BF-IV area. One bank shall be in operation and another bank shall remain on standby.
6. Approximate consumption shall be two (2) cylinders per hour. Supplier shall maintain a minimum of thirty-six (36) filled Jumbo LPG cylinders on a ready-to-move truck stationed inside RSP premises or at the entry gate, as directed by RSP, to ensure uninterrupted supply and quick changeover.
7. Complete logistics arrangement for regular and uninterrupted supply of LPG cylinders shall be the responsibility of the Supplier. Empty cylinder shall be filled up immediately by Supplier and returned back to RSP to avoid any disruption.
8. LPG cylinders shall be required for an estimated duration of 4 to 5 days. Supplier shall promptly collect empty cylinders upon instruction from RSP.
9. No Security deposit will be paid by RSP for Jumbo LPG cylinder.
10. There is no provision for any cylinder holding charge to be payable by SAIL-RSP (ie. Cylinders will be supplied to SAIL-RSP on free-holding/ rent-free basis).
11. Empty LPG Cylinders (after consumption of LPG Gas) shall be returned to Supplier through UCS code no. 72710001000075 of Empty LPG Cylinder.
12. Factory Sealed non consumed Jumbo LPG cylinder will be returned back to Supplier and no payment for such cylinders will be paid by RSP.
13. Any leakage, defective valve, or damaged cylinder shall be replaced immediately by Supplier at no extra cost.
14. The order quantity may be increased/ decreased by upto (+/-) 25% of the bid quantity as per the requirement of SAIL-RSP. The order quantity may be increased by 25% and order validity shall be extended accordingly, unilaterally by RSP. Vendor should be in a position to supply the additional quantity (+25% of the bid qty) within the delivery period, without any other changes in the terms and conditions of the contract. The bidders are required to confirm acceptance of the same in the techno-commercial offer.
15. **Bidders are advised to submit their price “per Kg of Propane-rich LPG” on landed cost basis (inclusive of discount in % of basic price and all applicable Taxes) in the price bid only. Bidders are requested to confirm the % of discount offered, in the techno-commercial Bid, which shall remain firm for the entire duration of the contract.**
16. Bidders are advised to submit their offer with reference to the **price prevailing for the month of May 2026.**
17. Cylinders shall be supplied with no external damage and in factory sealed condition. In case of

any abnormality with respect to gas quality in any cylinder, the same shall be replaced by the party, free of cost, using his own transport, immediately.

18. Supplier to ensure that the quality & safety of the gas cylinders to be supplied to SAIL-RSP will be as per the Gas Cylinders Rules, 2016 & PESO guidelines. Supplier should also ensure other statutory compliances including BIS requirements as well as compliances for supply & transportation of LPG in "Jumbo" cylinders (425 Kg).

19. Supplier to ensure that the "Jumbo" cylinders are shipped directly from the bottling plant to the premises of SAIL-RSP, without any intermediate offloading or temporary storage at unauthorized commercial godowns.

20. SAIL-RSP reserves the right to fore-close the order with 15 days prior intimation to the supplier.

### **III. DELIVERY REQUIREMENT:**

- Delivery period - 180 days, wherein, the delivery will be done in phases, as per requirement of RSP.
- The requirement shall be intimated in advance i.e., (4-5) working days.
- The above schedule, is however, tentative and will be clearly indicated in the back-up purchase order to be issued by SAIL-RSP after placement of the GeM Contract.
- Full Cylinders shall be supplied at BF-IV site or any other location within RSP as instructed.

**IV. GUARANTEE CLAUSE:** Guarantee & Test certificates must accompany each supply.

**V. PRICE VARIATION CLAUSE:** Price variation is applicable (as per the Ruling on the date of dispatch).

**VI. PACKAGING CLAUSE:** Material is to be supplied in "Jumbo" Cylinders of Capacity: 422 Kg/ 425 Kg; Cylinders shall be supplied with no external damage and in factory sealed condition.

**VII. INSPECTION TERM:** Inspection by Rourkela Steel Plant on the basis of Test Certificate, Guarantee Certificate, Cylinder condition and other terms and conditions mentioned in the Purchase Order.

**VIII. PAYMENT TERM:** Standard payment as per GeM.

### **BIDDERS TO NOTE:**

1. Bidder must submit filled Annexure-A, Annexure - B (Format for undertaking by the bidder) along with the offer. Formats attached in the bid document.
2. The offers of bidder(s) whose performance in SAIL-Rourkela Steel Plant (RSP) have been found to be unsatisfactory may not be considered and SAIL-RSP reserves the right to summarily reject such offers during any stage of tender, including and after price discovery.
3. In case any adverse report is received against a bidder, as an information or upon enquiry made by SAIL, in respect to capabilities and performance of the bidder, after receipt of the tender (even after opening of price bid), the quotation/ tender submitted by such bidder will be liable to be rejected on the grounds of the adverse report(s) received.

### **4. Other terms**

- i. NO DEVIATIONS ARE ACCEPTABLE. By submitting offer against this bid, the bidder is accepting all terms & conditions of the bid as well as GeM terms & conditions.
- ii. All prices quoted in GeM will be on landed cost basis, inclusive of GST and all taxes/ duties (unless otherwise specified in Special Terms of ATC).
- iii. Bidders are requested to update the firm's GST registration status prior to participating in the bid. Since all prices to be quoted in GeM are on landed cost basis, inclusive of GST and all taxes/ duties, the case will be evaluated accordingly.
- iv. Only relevant document(s) are to be uploaded for technical and commercial scrutiny. Submission of additional documents beyond the requirement will not be taken cognizance of. By participating in the bid, the Bidder agrees to comply with all terms and conditions without making any alterations, additions, or modifications. Any attempt by the Bidder to include additional terms or clauses in the bid document may result in the bid being rejected by the Buyer at any stage of the evaluation process. The Buyer reserves the right to take appropriate action, including but not limited to disqualification of the Bidder, cancellation of the bid and cancellation of order, at its sole discretion.
- v. Bidders to compulsorily submit the duly-filled Annexures with stamp and signature of authorized representative, as part of online offer.

vi. Any technical query/ clarification, is to be routed through the pre-bid representation functionality available against this bid.

vii. Risk purchase (RPN) clause: Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, if the Supplier neglects or fails to perform the Agreement by the time or times agreed upon, for any reason other than Force Majeure, the Purchaser after having come to know of such negligence or non-performance, after giving 14 to 30 days notice or any such extended period that the Supplier and Purchaser may mutually agree, to the Supplier to rectify, shall take such action as it considers fit including but not limited to taking risk purchase action for supply of the material, mitigating any losses, at the risk and cost of the Supplier as far as the undelivered quantity in that Delivery Period is concerned. The Right of the Purchaser for Risk Purchase Action is in addition to the Right of Purchaser to terminate the Contract due to the fault of the Supplier. The price differential in case of higher cost to SAIL, if any, shall have to be borne by the defaulting Supplier. Moreover, the defaulting Supplier shall have no claim over the quantity, which they failed to supply.

viii. Before dispatching the material, seller(s) must ensure the following:-

a. GeM contract is duly accepted.

b. GeM fees has been paid (if any, for contract acceptance)

c. GeM contract should remain valid till receipt of material at consignee location.

d. Invoices have been created in GeM, confirming dispatch of material

ix. SAIL-RSP will be placing back-up order against GeM contract(s) on successful bidder(s). SAIL-RSP's back-up purchase order, however, will be released only after acceptance of contract by seller in GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and

published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.

8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

**All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.**

**The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:**

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

**All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.**

**This Bid is governed by the General Terms and Conditions, conditions stipulated in Bid and Service Level Agreement specific to the Service, as the case may be, as provided in the Marketplace.**

**However, in case of Service, if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement specific to said Service, then it will over-ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.**
