1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
2. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.
3. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.
4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and

based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

5. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.

6. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

## Annexure -A

### TERMS & CONDITIONS

**Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) through Outsourcing For 220 kV Panipat - Charkhi Dadri Single Circuit Transmission Line: -**

#### 1. Eligibility & Past Experience:

The bidder should have past experience of executing similar nature of work as under:

- Average Annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31<sup>st</sup> March of the previous financial year, should be at least 30% of estimated cost.
- Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which bids are invited should be either of the following: -
  - Three Similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated amount
  - Or**
  - Two Similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.
  - Or**
  - One Similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.

## **2. Experience Certificate**

Experience certificates must be issued by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer (XEN) or equivalent. Original certificates shall be produced on demand.

## **3. Statutory Registrations**

The bidder shall submit valid EPF, ESI, PAN and GST registrations online. Original documents and enlistment certificates shall be produced whenever demanded by BBMB.

## **4. Labour Law Compliance / Zero Margin Policy**

Service providers quoting zero margin shall not be considered for award of contract as per applicable outsourcing and labour law compliance policy.

## **5. Minimum Wage & Cost Compliance**

Any bid submitted below the total of Minimum Wages, EPF, ESI, Bonus, Administrative Charges, GST and TDS (as applicable) shall be liable to rejection.

## **6. Premium Quotation**

The bidder must quote a premium of more than 2% of the estimated amount (**as per Annexure-C (i) & (ii)**). Bids quoting premium equal to or less than 2% shall be rejected. Premium shall be considered up to two decimal places only.

## **7. Bid Evaluation & Negotiation**

Evaluation and negotiation, if required, shall be carried out strictly as per GEM guidelines and BBMB rules/orders adopted from time to time, with approval of the competent authority. Negotiation, if any, shall be conducted only with L-1 bidder(s).

## **8. Tie-Breaker Clause**

In case more than one bidder is declared L-1, a merit list shall be prepared on the basis of average annual turnover of the best three (03) years out of the last five (05) years. A certificate from a Registered Chartered Accountant for the last five years' turnover shall be submitted. Preference shall be given to the bidder having the highest average turnover.

## **9. Minimum Wages**

Minimum wages shall be considered as per the latest Chief Labour Commissioner (CLC) rates for the year 2025-26, including EPF, ESI, EDLI, administrative charges, bonus and other statutory liabilities.

## **10. Scope of Work**

The work shall be carried out strictly as per the detailed Scope of Work (**Annexure -B**) and shall include routine and emergency patrolling, breakdown and shutdown maintenance, inspection of towers, conductors, insulators, hardware, earth wire, tree trimming, earthing, painting, foundation checking, preventive monsoon and pre-winter maintenance, and all activities as per BBMB checklist and instructions of field officers.

## **11. Manpower Deployment**

The contractor shall deploy adequate skilled manpower as per the approved deployment for execution of the work. Any shortfall in skilled manpower shall be treated as breach of contract and recovered on pro-rata basis from the contractor's bills.

## **12. Emergency Response Time**

The contractor shall mobilize manpower and attend any emergency or breakdown within two (02) hours of intimation. Failure to do so shall attract penalty as decided by the competent authority.

## **13. Shutdown & System Coordination**

All works shall be carried out only after obtaining proper shutdown and clearance from the concerned control authority. Any work carried out without valid shutdown shall be treated as a serious violation and may lead to termination of contract.

## **14. Responsibility During Faults / Accidents**

In case of tripping, accident or damage to line or third-party property due to negligence of contractor staff, the contractor shall be fully responsible and losses shall be recoverable from the contractor.

## **15. Safety, Tools & Insurance**

The contractor shall provide all safety equipment to deployed manpower. The contractor shall arrange workmen compensation and insurance. BBMB shall not be responsible for any accident or loss of life.

## **16. Replacement of Manpower**

BBMB reserves the right to demand replacement of any manpower found unskilled, negligent or undisciplined, without assigning any reason.

**17. No Claim Clause**

No claim shall be admissible on account of idle manpower, non-availability of shutdown, weather conditions or system constraints.

**18. Payment Terms**

Payment shall be made on monthly basis after satisfactory performance and verification and shall be governed by prevailing CLC rates at the time of payment.

**19. Penalty / Liquidated Damages**

Penalty or liquidated damages shall be imposed for poor performance, delay or violation of terms as per BBMB and GEM rules. Repeated lapses may lead to termination of contract.

**20. Rejection of Bids**

BBMB reserves the right to reject any or all bids or withdraw the invitation without assigning any reason. Conditional tenders are not acceptable.

**21. Cost of Bidding**

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with preparation and submission of the bid. BBMB shall not be liable for any such costs.

**22. Bid Validity**

The bid shall remain valid for three (03) months from the date of opening of bids.

**23. Holiday Clause**

If the date of issue, receipt or opening of tender happens to be a holiday, the same shall be done on the next working day.

**24. Governing Instructions**

Any condition not specifically covered herein shall be governed by GEM General Conditions of Contract (GCC) and BBMB rules/orders issued or adopted from time to time.

**25. Jurisdiction**

All disputes shall be subject to BBMB rules and regulations and jurisdiction of the competent court.

## Annexure -B

**Scope of Work****A) MAINTENANCE OF OVERHEAD AND UNDERGROUND TRANSMISSION LINES**

**1. Routine Inspection** — To be carried out by the patroller as per the instructions of the concerned XEN / SDO / JE to check:

- a) General condition of towers, poles, gantry, structures, insulators, hardware, conductors, earthing systems, vibration dampers, guard wire, and earth wire cum fiber optic cable.
- b) Condition of foundations.
- c) Tower/pole accessories such as name plate, number plate, danger board, phase plate, anti-climbing device.
- d) Any theft or broken of tower parts, bracings, conductor, or related components.
- e) Right-of-way issues — trees close to the lines that require pruning, unauthorized constructions under or near the line.
- f) Sagging of line conductors or guard wire.

**2. Emergency Inspection and Reporting** — As per instructions of XEN / SDO / JE:

- a) Whenever any circuit trips / Auto-Recloses and comes into service.
- b) Whenever any circuit trips and tests faulty.
- c) Emergency reporting by Firm is mandatory.
- d) Immediate mobilization of manpower for fault attending and restoration works.

**3. Detailed Inspection** — As per instructions of SDO / JE:

- a) Availing outage and closely inspecting conductors and hardware for any deterioration that could cause future breakdown.
- b) Visual inspection without outage using binoculars.

The installation will be inspected according to the BBMB checklist, by patrollers trained for transmission line

e inspection. The reasons for tripping should be reported immediately.

#### **4. Monitoring of Hot Spots —**

The identified hot spots by BBMB shall be attended by the Firm as per BBMB Check list i.e. at dead-end connections, clamps, PG clamps, loop connectors, repair sleeves, and mid-span joints etc.

#### **5. Maintenance Work (Material & T&P required shall be arranged by the BBMB):**

- a) Replace corroded, cracked, or flashed insulators (disc/pin).
- b) Replace PG clamps with compression type, loop/wedge connectors.
- c) Repair / re-tension conductors, OPGW / GI earth wire, provide guard laces, stay wires.
- d) Repair structure stays / members.
- e) Repair structure footing / stub (BBMB to provide material).
- f) Install bird flappers or other measures to reduce / eliminate transient faults.
- g) Minor repairs to structure grounds as per IS specifications.
- h) Trim trees under / near lines regularly (offline). Fabricate and fix missing tower members, including tack welding.
- i) Load / unload transmission tower materials, poles, cables, conductors, etc.
- j) Replace barbed wire / anti-climbing devices.
- k) Paint towers (paint supplied by BBMB).
- l) Assist in breakdowns not covered under AMC, limited to manpower, tools and supervisory support, as and when directed by BBMB. Any major repair, material replacement or specialized work shall be dealt with separately and shall not form part of AMC payment.
- m) Treat structure footings (Material supplied by BBMB).
- n) Maintain structure grounds.
- o) Install danger boards on tower lines (Material supplied by BBMB).
- p) Status of earthing. Taking earth resistance as per ISO procedures.
- q) Cleaning of Disk Insulators during shut down of line.
- r) Upkeeping of T&P items.
- s) Carrying out minor emergency repairs required for quick restoration of line under shutdown or emergency conditions.

#### **6. Pre Monsoon & Pre Winter Maintenance:**

- a) Inspect line corridor.
- b) Cut / trim trees where required.
- c) Check foundation, revetment, soil levelling.
- d) Carry out shutdown / non-shutdown maintenance if required.
- e) Preventive Maintenance as per BBMB Check List.

#### **7. Reporting:**

- a) Submit fortnightly/monthly patrolling & tripping checklist in BBMB format.
- b) Submit emergency / shutdown work completion reports after restoration.

#### **Other Conditions:**

1. Staff to be headquartered at TL Office, Panipat.
2. Accommodation near vicinity of Head Quarter should be taken care by the firm.
3. Outstation lodging / boarding by BBMB.
4. Tools will be provided by BBMB.
5. Safety Equipment's to be provided by the Firm.
6. One weekly rest shall be given to the Staff; in case of any emergency on Rest / Gazetted holidays, firm has to provide the staff.
7. Any shortfall in man-days as per approved deployment shall be recovered on pro-rata basis from the contractor's bills.
8. EPF, ESI, insurance to be borne by the firm.
9. Full responsibility for Panipat - Charkhi Dadri S/C Line maintenance.

15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

**All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.**
