compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
