1. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) from the State of Bid Inviting Authority : Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as Micro and Small Enterprises from the State of Bid inviting Authority. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for percentage of 100 % of total quantity as defined/ decided in relevant policy.

2. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

3. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

RE: Procurement of Solid Alum (Grade-IV) for the F/Y- 2025-2026

1) All intending bidders should qualify eligibility criteria for the purpose of SOLID ALUM GRADE-IV. If any of the participating tenderer fails to qualify any of the terms & conditions mentioned below, the particular tender will be declared informal/non-responsive.

2) i) Only Manufacturers are eligible to participate in the tender. Manufactures should produce valid BIS certification of manufacturers as on opening date of tender for SOLID ALUM GRADE -IV as per IS 299:2012.

ii) a) Intending tenderers should produce credentials of a similar nature of completed work of the minimum value of 40% (Forty percent) of estimated amount put to tender during 5 (five) years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice;

Or,

b) Intending tenderers should produce credentials of 2(two) similar nature of completed work, each of the minimum value of 30 % (Thirty percent) of the estimated amount put to tender during 5 (five) years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice;

Or,

c) Intending tenderers should produce credentials of one single running work of similar nature which has been completed to the extent of 80 % (Eighty percent) or more and value of which is not less than the desired value at (a) above;

In case of running works, only those tenderers who will submit the certificate of satisfactory running work from the concerned Executive Engineer, or equivalent competent authority will be eligible for the tender. In the required certificate it should be clearly stated that the work is in progress satisfactorily and also that no penal action has been initiated against the executing agency, i.e., the tenderer.

- Similar nature of work includes supply of Solid alum (grade-2, 4) or Liquid alum (Grade-3, 5).
- Completed work- Completed single or multiple purchase orders issued from a single tender.
- Payment certificate will not be treated as credential;
- Credential certificate issued by Executive engineer or equivalent or competent authority of a State/Central Government, State/ Central Government undertaking, Statutory/Autonomous bodies constituted under the Central/State statute, on the executed value of completed/running work will be taken as credential.

iii) Tenderer should produce valid PAN issued by IT Department, Govt. Of India, valid 15-digit Goods and Services tax payer Identification Number (GSTIN) under GST Act, 2017, latest Professional Tax returns copy and certificate. In case of manufacturing unit Factory License is to be submitted. Balance sheet & ITR for last 2 years, Signed copy of ATC is to be mandatorily uploaded as a testimony of acceptance of all terms & conditions put up in the Bid document. Trade license will be mandatory for those whose manufacturing unit is located within the jurisdiction of KMC

iv) A declaration in non judicial stamp paper of Rs 10/- should be submitted stating that the applicant is not debarred /blacklisted by Govt. /Govt. Undertaking/Statutory Bodies established by an act of central or state government/ Municipal Body as on date of submission of bid. In case the bidder suffers from any blacklisting/ debarment by any Govt. / undertaking (Govt.) / Municipal Corporation in any tender at the time of submission of bid, it will not be eligible to participate in the tender.

3) The eligibility of a bidder will be ascertained on the basis of the document(s) in support of the eligibility criteria as mentioned in Clause 2 above. If any document submitted by a bidder is either manufactured or false, in such cases the eligibility of the bidder / tenderer will be rejected at any stage without any prejudice.

4) Suppliers will have to unload materials inside IGWTP/GRWW at their own cost and at their own responsibility.

5) The maximum weight of each consignment should be restricted within 30 MT (including the weight of the vehicle).

6) The consignment must reach IGWTP/GRWW by 12.00 noon on weekdays and by 11.00 A.M on Saturdays to avoid unnecessary detention. Each consignment must be accompanied by four copies of challan.

7) Each consignment will be tested by the authorized laboratory at IGWTP/ GRWW. Only approved materials will be accepted. If any material is found defective after supply, the same is to be replaced free of cost.

8) The failure in testing for more than three occasions, may lead to cancelation of order and forfeiture of SD and debarment of the company for participating in any tender of KMC for 5 years.

9) Materials (ALUMINO FERRIC GRADE-IV as per IS 299:2012) conforming to BIS specification with latest amendment will only be accepted.

10) Suppliers must submit manufacturer's Test Certificate for every consignment of Solid Alum.

11) During weighing and collection of samples the supplier is requested to send an authorized representative. If the representative is not present at the time of weighing and sampling the decision of KMC will be final and no objection in these regards will be entertained in future.

12) Pre-bid meeting will be conducted at the chamber of Controller of Stores & Purchase on 09.10.2025 at 1PM and all the interested participants are requested to attend the meeting for any query or information. If any major query/information is there this is to be submitted in writing during pre-bid meeting.

13) Offer shall remain valid for a period of 365 days from the date of opening of tender for acceptance. Once accepted, the offer should remain valid for full financial year or 365 days from the date of opening of tender whichever is later. If the bidder withdraws the bid during the validity period of bid, the earnest money as deposited will be forfeited forthwith without assigning any reason thereof. Orders will be issued in phased manner within the validity period of the tender and throughout the jurisdiction of KMC.

14) Quoted price should include statutory payments (like GST or any other Govt. taxes if applicable). Escalation of Price on any ground and subsequent cost overrun shall not be entertained under any circumstances. Rates should be quoted accordingly.

15) Successful Bidder should submit (after opening of financial/price bid) a separate price break-up analysis whenever asked for. Such price break-up must contain the components from where it can clearly be understood how the present quoted/offered rate (price) has been arrived.

16) The unit of measurement is 'Container' which is equivalent to '1 MT (Metric Ton)'. Each 'Container' should contain 50 nos of 20 kg slab i.e. 1 MT in total.

In this regard a declaration in non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.10/- should be submitted by the applicant that it has understood that the unit of measure 'Container' means 'One Metric Ton'. The applicant has to quote the rate considering the mentioned unit i.e. 'Container'.

17) Supply must be completed within the delivery period mentioned in Purchase Order. Delay in supply may invite penal action against the vendor. The vendor may be debarred or participating in any tender of KMC for 5 years.

The successful bidder is required to take note that the material will be received in four installments mentioned in the Purchase Order. But the schedule may change in future if the situation so demands.

18) Successful bidder has to provide a security deposit in the form of e-PBG of 5% of the order value as per GeM format.

19) The price preference will be governed by the notification vide no. 10500-F of West Bengal Financial Rule (WBFR) issued by Govt. of West Bengal Finance Department, Audit Branch.

20) The Solid Alum (Gr-IV) as per IS 299:2012, must be manufactured from Alumina hydrate and virgin Sulphuric acid, use of Bauxite and spent Sulphuric acid are strictly prohibited for manufacturing of Solid alum. A declaration by the bidder is required to be submitted for the above.

21) Bid splitting is not allowed.
