Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

2. Generic

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

3. **Service & Support**

AVAILABILITY OF OFFICE OF SERVICE PROVIDER: An office of the Service Provider must be located in the state of Consignee. DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE TO BE SUBMITTED.

4. **Service & Support**

Dedicated /toll Free Telephone No. for Service Support : BIDDER/OEM must have Dedicated/toll Free Telephone No. for Service Support.

5. **Service & Support**

Escalation Matrix For Service Support : Bidder/OEM must provide Escalation Matrix of Telephone Numbers for Service Support.

6. **Service & Support**

In the event where the distance travelled exceeds the monthly usage variant, amount will be paid for additional Kms as per schedule. Similarly, the unused Kms in a particular month as against the minimum guaranteed usage variant will be carried forward to the next month and additional Km if any in the next month shall be adjusted against this. However, the payment for the selected usage variant in a month will be paid every month." Further, the unused Kms in a particular month shall not be carried forward or adjusted beyond 6 months

7. **Payment**

PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND WAGES: Service Provider is required to pay Salaries / wages of contracted staff deployed at buyer location first i.e. on their own and then claim payment from Buyer alongwith all statutory documents like, PF, ESIC etc. as well as the bank statement of payment done to staff.

8. **Certificates**

A/C (Name of the Seller). The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of Security Deposit, the FDR will be released in favour of bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. 1. ALL VEHICLES PROVIDED SHALL HAVE ALL THE NECESSARY PERMITS/LICENSES/CLEARANCES SUCH AS, BUT NOT LIMITED TO FITNESS CERTIFICATE, PUC, FULL COMPREHENSIVE INSURANCE, ROAD PERMIT, REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE, AS PER THE MOTOR VEHICLES ACT, RTO AND OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS AND STATUTORY BODIES.
2. FIRM MUST PROVIDE COMMERCIAL (TOURIST) VEHICLES FOR THIS SERVICE.
3. CONTRACTORS MUST READ THE NEW HIRING POLICY CONDITIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE QUOTING THE TENDER.
4. NIGHT CHARGES WILL NOT BE APPLICABLE.
5. CONTRACTORS LOCATED IN MAHARASHTRA STATE WILL ONLY BE ELIGIBLE TO QUOTE THE TENDER.
6. OFFERS OF CONTRACTORS LOCATING OUTSIDE MAHARASHTRA WILL BE PASSED OVER.
7. FIRMS TO ATTACH COMPLETION CERTIFICATE IN SUPPORT OF PAST PERFORMANCE/ EXPERIENCE.

9. PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE AT A RATE OF 5% OF THE CONTRACTUAL VALUE SHALL BE DEPOSITED BY THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER WITHIN 30 (THIRTY) DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE OF LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE (LOA). EXTENSION OF TIME FOR SUBMISSION OF PG BEYOND 30 (THIRTY) DAYS AND UPTO THE DATE OF SUBMISSION OF PG FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE OF LOA MAY BE GIVEN BY THE AUTHORITY WHO IS COMPETENT TO SIGN THE CONTRACT AGREEMENT. HOWEVER, A PENAL INTEREST OF 15% PER ANNUM SHALL BE CHARGED FOR THE DELAY BEYOND 30 (THIRTY) DAYS, I.E. FROM 31ST DAY AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUE OF LOA. IN CASE THE CONTRACTOR FAILS TO SUBMIT THE REQUISITE PG AFTER 60 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE OF LOA, A NOTICE SHALL BE SERVED TO THE CONTRACTOR TO DEPOSIT THE PG IMMEDIATELY HOWEVER NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE OF LOA). IN CASE THE CONTRACTOR FAILS TO SUBMIT THE REQUISITE PG EVEN AFTER 90 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE OF LOA, THE CONTRACT SHALL BE TERMINATED DULY FORFEITING EMO AND OTHER DUES, IF ANY PAYABLE AGAINST THAT CONTRACT. THE FAILED CONTRACTOR SHALL BE DEBARRED FROM PARTICIPATING IN RETENDER FOR THAT WORK. IN CASE 60TH DAY IS A BANK HOLIDAY OR OFFICE CLOSURE NEXT WORKING DAY SHOULD BE CONSIDERED AS THE LAST DAY FOR SUBMISSION OF THE PGS. DECISION OF AUTHORITY COMPETENT TO SIGN THE CONTRACT AGREEMENT WOULD BE FINAL IN CASE OF ANY DISPUTE.

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. By making a bid pursuant to the Tender Documents, the bidder / tenderer shall be deemed to have declared that the bidder's / tenderer's service contract related to vehicle has not been terminated due to bad performance in Mumbai/Nav Mumbai region in last 6(six) months. If above mentioned adverse performance comes in the notice of the buyer, he may disqualify the offer during evaluation stage.

2. Performance Guarantee: The value of performance guarantee is 5% of the value of contract, with validity of 6 months above the contract period. The performance guarantee should be submitted within 30 days from contract generation date to user department which shall stand refundable after successful completion

n of the contract subject to certificate from user department that there are no pending dues whatsoever against the contractor.

Special Conditions for Circle-1 (Mumbai Region upto Thane) are as below :

1. The hiring of vehicle service will be in 2 parts (of the same Work) as below :

a. Deployment and operations of the vehicle service:

- i. Contractor shall provide Vehicles inclusive of fuel requirements, on a monthly basis.
- ii. The Service Provider shall ensure that all maintenance works related to the assigned vehicle will be carried out in off-duty hours and shall be periodically checked and maintained by the Service Provider to avoid any inconvenience to the buyer along with other necessary requirements for regular washing/cleaning and all the necessary permits/licenses/clearances such as, but not limited to fitness certificate, PUC, full comprehensive insurance, road permit, registration certificate, as per the Motor Vehicles Act, RTO and other applicable laws and statutory bodies, for providing commercial vehicles for this service, and all other conditions as per the GeM model contract w.r.t. the deployment and operations of the vehicle service (except w.r.t. excluding driver's payment, which is covered separately in part 'b' below).
- iii. Deductions for non-compliance of standards of the services as per Contract as applicable to the vehicle service (except traffic violations pertaining to driver's responsibility) shall be made from the payment made to Service Provider (Contractor).
- iv. Price Variation Clause (PVC) will be applicable as per the Contract.
- v. 'Extra per Kms charges' will be applicable as per the Contract. However, 'extra Kms' will be calculated as the total Kms run by all the vehicles included in the contract in that month beyond the 'Pooled' Kms of respective 'bundled Km/hour package' of all the vehicles within that contract. For example, if there are 3 vehicles with 1500 km x 320 hours package each in the contract, with run of 1200 Kms, 1700 Kms and 1800 Kms, respectively, in that month, then 'Extra per Kms charges' will be paid on the Kms run beyond pooled Km i.e. $(1200+1700+1800) - (1500+1500+1500) = 47$

00 - 4500 = 200 Km only.

- vi. 'No Extra hours charges' will be applicable on vehicles as the vehicles are hired for the full period of contract.
- vii. All other conditions as per GeM model contract.

b. Deployment of Driver:

- i. The Driver deployed should possess the requisite valid Driving License.
- ii. The criminal antecedents of the Driver should be verified with the Police Authority and the certificate to that effect should be furnished by the Service Provider.
- iii. The suitability of the Driver will be assessed and approved by the Officer for whom the vehicle person is being provided, prior to such engagement.
- iv. It is the responsibility of the service provider to always provide one driver per vehicle as per the requirement, while complying with the Labour Laws.
- v. The service provider shall provide at his own cost proper uniform and badges and photo identity cards to the drivers in compliance with the Motor Transport Workers Act.
- vi. 'Extra hour charges will be paid to the Driver as per the Contract.
- vii. Deductions for non-compliance of standards of the services as per Contract as applicable pertaining to driver's responsibility shall be made from the salary of the Driver paid by the Service Provider (Contractor).
- viii. The Salary to be paid to the Driver shall be according to minimum wages at the bottom of the paymatrix level 1 declared by the Railway Ministry+ DA as applicable, subject to Minimum Wage applicable as per below:

Note:

- a. The Circle will be defined as per the address of the Consignee for whom the vehicle service has been hired, for example, Kalyan will NOT fall in Circle-1.
 - b. The Gross salary will vary with change in DA or Minimum Wages by the Govt. of India as per the table above.
 - c. Service Provider (Contractor) shall submit the proof of any amount paid to the Government for the Driver(s) deployed against Statutory Employer Contributions viz. PF etc., which shall be paid by the Railway to the Service Provider against the invoice raised by the Service Provider.
2. Deductions-Statutory Employee contribution of PF, ESIC etc. (With basic as Rs. 18,000)
 3. Total salary = (a) + (b) above less Statutory Deductions viz. Drivers contribution of PF, ESIC etc. as applicable.
 4. Net payment = Total Salary + Extra hour charges as per (vi) above- Deductions as per (vii) above.
- ix. The wages of the Driver Date of payment for drivers Salary shall be paid by the Contractor on the last date of month.
 - x. The drivers/staff provided by the service provider shall not be deemed employees of the buyer hence the compliance of the applicable Labour Laws and Acts, Transport Motor workers Act and other relevant laws will be the sole responsibility of the service provider.
 - xi. The service provider shall be responsible for ensuring compliance with the provisions related to Labour Law [Central/State] and specially Minimum Wages Act, Payment of Wages Act, PF, ESI Act, Payment of Bonus Act, Contract Labour [R&A] Act, Workmen Compensation Act, Motor Vehicle Act, Motor Transport Workers Act, 1961 etc. and any other relevant acts as applicable at present or in future during the tenure of the contract and as may be forced from time to time. Onus of compliance of all the applicable Laws/Acts/Rules/Guidelines/ Notifications/ Regulations/ Orders shall rest with the service provider only and the buyer will not be liable in any manner.
 - xii. The Service Provider shall not deploy or shall

discontinue deploying the driver(s), if desired by the Buyer and must ensure prompt replacement of the driver(s) without any additional cost to the Buyer. The drivers being deployed shall ordinarily be continued and should not be changed without written intimation and consultation with Buyer.

- xiii. Price Variation Clause (PVC) will NOT be applicable to Driver's salary. However, the DA increase notified for the period of the contract and as applicable would be applied to the emoluments of the driver as mentioned above at viii (1) above.
- xiv. All other conditions as per GeM model contract.

Working of Railways is 24 x 7, hence drivers may be called at any time in emergent situation. Contractor must ensure availability of drivers whenever they are called. Necessary charges like night running, extra KM running, extra hours running will be paid additionally as per GeM SLA.

The Contractor shall be responsible for keeping the necessary spare pool of drivers for emergent situations when the regular driver is not available.

Deployed Vehicles and Drivers shall be solely in control of the Officer for whom they have been hired and Service Provider (Contractor) shall not have the right to deploy the deployed Vehicles or Drivers for any work at his discretion.

Tender Bid invited shall be selected based on the Bidders' quotes for the Cost Deployment and operations of the vehicle including profit of the contractor, as the Salary of Driver will be fixed as above.

- 2. **Invoicing** by Service Provider (Contractor): Single Payment GST Invoice shall be raised by the Contractor on a monthly basis, stating in 2 parts as below:
 - a. **Charges of Deployment and operations of the vehicle service** (for 1(a) above), and
 - b. **Emoluments paid to Driver(s)** (for 1(b) above) : Contractor shall submit Documentary proof before processing the bills of the Contractors by the Railway i.e. Attendance Sheet and Bank statement of having paid the Salary, Statutory Deductions viz. Drivers contribution of PF, ESIC etc., plus Extra hour charges' and minus Deductions for non-compliance of standards of the services as per Contract pertaining to the Driver, and Statutory Employer Contributions viz PF etc.

The GST applicable on respective items of the invoice shall be shown explicitly by the Service Provider on the GST Invoice raised.

The expense shall be booked to PU 32.

- 3. **Interim arrangement between 2 successive vehicle Contracts:** Interim hiring of vehicle service (with driver) until the new contract commences shall be done on quotation basis considering the urgency. The expense on such interim hiring of vehicle service (with driver) shall be charged to the same Work sanctioned for hiring of the vehicle with driver under which the contract was terminated.

NOTE:-

All other terms and conditions of the contract for Hiring of Vehicle Service, which is not specified above, will be governed by Service Level Agreement (SLA) for monthly basis cab & taxi hiring services of GeM Portal.

6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

This Bid is governed by the [सामान्य नियम और शर्तें/General Terms and Conditions](#), conditions stipulated in Bid and [Service Level Agreement](#) specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace. However in case if any condition specified in सामान्य नियम और शर्तें/General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.
