3. Buyer Added Bid Specific Scope Of Work(SOW)

Text Clause(s)

1. BACKGROUND

The initiatives for Alloy Steels Plant (ASP), Durgapur and Visvesvaraya Iron & Steel Plant (VISL), Bhadravathi emerged from a strategic workshop held on 18-19 July 2025 at MTI Ranchi. The objective was to align plant development plans with the Government of India's Atmanirbhar Bharat mission, which aims to strengthen domestic self-reliance in specialty and alloy steel through import substitution.

India's special & alloy steel sector, though representing only 6% of total steel consumption, is vital for defense, railways, aerospace, automotive, and infrastructure. The market is projected to expand from 6.9 MTPA in 2023-24 to 10 MTPA by 2029-30 (8% CAGR). However, forecasts indicate a supply gap of 1.73 MTPA by FY 2029-30, particularly in high-value segments like bars, wire rods, and high-grade forgings.

This gap, combined with the strategic importance of reducing dependency on imports, has driven the need for capacity expansion and modernization at ASP and VISL — with a focus on improving production efficiency

cy, introducing advanced steel grades, and enhancing downstream processing capabilities.

ASP/VISL is to be developed as specialised steel manufacturing units with focus also on: - Axle manufacturing (including railway, metro, high speed train axles) - Speciality roll manufacturing - Alloy steel bars, rounds and forgings

The revival plan may include Greenfield and/or Brownfield development with suitable steelmaking, casting, rolling, forging and finishing facilities, along with utilities and infrastructure, keeping in view future expansion and Green Steel provisions.

The details and status of ASP and VISL are as below:

Alloy Steels Plant (ASP),Durgapur

Alloy Steels Plant (ASP) was established at Durgapur, West Bengal in early sixties as India's first major producer of high alloy and special steels. With the help of two-phase modernization program, ASP had raised its initial capacity of 1,00,000 T of liquid steel and 60,000 T saleable steel to present capacity of 2,34,000 T and 1,84,000 T respectively.

The steel melting Shop has three 50T Electric Arc Furnaces with secondary steel making facilities like Vacuum arc Degassing (VAD), Vacuum Oxygen decarburization (VOD), Ladle Furnace (LF), Argon Oxygen Decarburization (AOD) to produce quality steel through bottom pouring ingot and continuous casting route.

The ingots are subjected to either rolling or forging process at ASP for producing varied shapes & sizes. The ingots are rolled at Blooming and Billet Mill for producing blooms, billets, rounds and slabs in a variety of steel grades & sizes. The rolled slabs are further rolled in Plate mill to produce plates. The Forge Shop produces products like step forgings, rounds, rolls, die blocks etc. from the ingots. The production units are supplemented by finishing facilities with two Conditioning Shops and Heat Treatment & Finishing shop where specific customer requirements are taken care of.

In present days ASP saleable steel production is limited to approximately 1.2Lac ton per annum due to (1) mainly non availability of orders in ConCast route and (2) higher cost of production in Ingot route. Gradually ASP has lost its market share and now limited to 2% only. High cost of production and narrow product range are the main the attributor for the lower market share.

ASP has surplus land of about 200 acres within its plant boundary kept for future expansions.

Visvesvaraya Iron & Steel Plant (VISL), Bhadravathi

Visvesvaraya Iron & Steel Plant (VISL) is a unit of Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL), located at Bhadravathi, Karnataka. VISL has a legacy of manufacturing special steels and alloy steel products catering to strategic and industrial sectors. At present, the steelmaking facilities are non-operational.

Steel Blooms are sourced from ASP Durgapur, BSP Bhilai, ISP Burnpur and are being rolled/forged at VISL presently.

Rolling, forging and finishing facilities exist, however the remnant life of these facilities, needs to be studied and are to be revived and augmented or replaced as the case may be.

The total available land is around 532 Acres within the plant boundary, which includes around 100-150 Acres area covered by old/existing 0.2 MTPA plant complex. This old plant has been in shut down condition since 2017. This area of old plant may also be used for new plant/ facility if required. Total area including the township is about 1661 Acres. If required, the plant boundary may be extended.

SAIL intends to engage a reputed Consultant for preparation of an Approach Note (Pre-Feasibility Report) and a Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the above purpose for both the plants separately. Synergy between the two plants may be explored for efficient business models.

2. SCOPE OF WORK OF CONSULTANT

The scope of consultancy services shall broadly include:

- Preparation of Approach Note (Pre-Feasibility Report)
- Assistance for Environmental Clearance (after approval of Pre-FR)
- Soil Investigation , Underground Mapping & survey work (as applicable after approval of Pre-FR)
- Preparation of Detailed Project Reports (DPR)
- All the above activities to be carried out for both the plants separately.

3. PREPARATION OF APPROACH NOTE (PRE-FEASIBILITY REPORT)

The Approach Note (Pre-FR) shall be prepared for management go-ahead and statutory processing and shall include:

- Proposed product mix (blooms,billets,rounds,CC slabs/blooms,plates, axles, rolls, alloy steel bars/rounds, forgings, etc.)
- Process route options (EAF/IF/secondary metallurgy/continuous and or ingot casting, rolling & forging, adoption of green steel production)
- Capacity of individual units
- Process flow diagrams
- Material & utility balance
- Broad layout and land utilisation
- Block cost estimates for major units
- Packaging and dispatch strategy
- Environmental load, waste management and ZLD concept
- Broad implementation schedule

The consultant shall: - Make presentations at ASP/VISL/SAIL levels - Prepare Board Note and annexures as per SAIL format - Assist ASP/VISL/SAIL in addressing queries for go-ahead approval

4. ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE (POST PRE-FR APPROVAL)

The Consultant shall:

- Prepare and submit Terms of Reference (TOR)
- Conduct Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)
- Prepare Environment Management Plan (EMP)
- Assist in public hearing and presentations before statutory authorities
- Support ASP/VISL/SAIL till grant of Environmental Clearance

5. SOIL INVESTIGATION , UNDERGROUND MAPPING & SURVEY WORK

The Consultant shall arrange geotechnical investigation and underground mapping through specialised agencies. The extent of work shall depend on the finalised layout and shall be defined in the Pre-FR. Payments for this activity shall be on actual execution basis.

6. PREPARATION OF DETAILED PROJECT REPORT (DPR)

The two separate DPR is to submitted for each plant. The DPR shall be comprehensive and suitable for financial appraisal, project sanction and implementation. It shall cover, but not be limited to, the following:

6.1 Product Mix: Detailed product mix with grades, sizes based on market research and target applications. Special quality requirements for axles, rolls and alloy steels are to be analyzed & incorporated in the DPR.

6.2 Description of Production Facilities: Area/Shop wise facilities viz., Raw material handling, Steel making facilities, Casting facilities, Rolling mills, Forging presses, Heat treatment, Axle & roll machining and finishing, internal & external logistics to be described & brought out clearly. Details like description of capacity, process parameters, major equipment, technical parameters, specifications, capacity calculations, material balance with reference to upstream & downstream capacities, waste management are to be clearly spelt out.

6.3 Raw Material Requirement: Quantity, quality and sources of raw material viz., iron ore/DRI-HBI/scrap, alloys, fuels and consumables to be analyzed and detailed out. Storage and handling systems required are to be specified.

6.4 Utility Systems: Water, power, fuels, gases, compressed air, etc., their source, quantity & distribution shall be detailed out. The whole proposal will be designed based on Zero Liquid Discharge concept. Further the design should comply with all the extant statutory & environmental norms of State & Central Governments. Focus should be on energy efficiency and waste heat recovery.

6.5 Power Receiving & Distribution System: Load estimation, Power sourcing, Substations and distribution network etc., to be detailed out. Provision for renewable/solar power to be considered. Facilities to maintain power quality and to attain maximum power factor, minimum harmonics etc to be included.

6.6 Automation, Instrumentation & Digitalisation: Level 0-4 automation architecture to be implemented throughout. Manufacturing Execution System (MES) and ERP integration to be ensured. Predictive maintenance, digital twins and analytics etc., to be included.

6.7 Auxiliary & Supporting Facilities: Workshops, laboratories, stores, offices and welfare facilities to be set up. Identification of dismantling and relocation of existing facilities/ structures, if any, will be done by the consultant and mentioned.

6.8 Environmental Management: Emission control systems, Solid waste and slag management, Green belt development (as per CPCB Norm), Rainwater harvesting, Provisions for Green Steel, hydrogen, Carbon Capture Usage and Storage (CCUS) etc., to be addressed

6.9 Safety: Safety systems for construction and operation to be brought out clearly.

6.10 Layout & Site Development: Overall plant layout (2D & 3D), Inbound and outbound logistics (rail/road), piping network, conveyor routes, underground and over ground facilities, sewerage network, storm water drainage etc, provision for future expansion, site grading, cutting and filling, dismantling, relocation/retrofitting of existing facilities, if required & other enabling work, as required to be addressed.

6.11 Civil Work: The consultant will indicate in the DPR, the type of civil foundation work envisaged as per the site conditions. Construction methodology/ consideration, if any, in the given site condition shall

also be indicated.

6.12 Statutory Clearances: List of approvals required at various stages to be enumerated.

6.13 Execution Strategy: Packaging philosophy, Indigenous sourcing as per Atmanirbhar Bharat, Implementation schedule, List of probable bidders for major packages etc to be addressed.

6.14 Financial Aspects: Capital cost estimate with breakup, Working capital margin, IDC and pre-operative expenses, Techno-economic analysis shall be included in the DPR.

Approach Note (Pre-FR) and General layout, along with brief write-up on Facilities & logistics/ constraints suitable for taking TOR (Environmental clearance) will be submitted by the consultant within Four (04) weeks from effective date of contract. The Approach Note (Pre-FR) would consist of:

- General Layout
- Major facilities with capacity and technological features
- Major Utilities like water, fuel, power and gases
- Environmental Load
- Waste Management

- Zero Liquid Discharge
- Broad Cost of the project with break up w.r.t. major facilities.
- Manpower requirement
- Implementation schedule w.r.t. major facilities

Presentation /Discussion & acceptance of Approach Note (Pre-FR) and General Layout:

The Approach Note (Pre-FR) & General layout Drawing shall be presented by the consultant to SAIL /ASP/VISL. Approach Note (Pre-FR) and General layout will be duly discussed, and comments provided by client, updated by consultant & accepted by SAIL/ASP/VISL.

Go-ahead clearance by SAIL/ASP/VISL for further activities

After acceptance of Approach Note (Pre-FR), SAIL/ASP/VISL shall provide Go-ahead clearance for taking up completion of further activities as detailed below.

Environmental Clearance:

Based on the accepted Approach Note (Pre-FR) and general layout, the consultant shall initiate the required activities for obtaining environmental clearance. This shall be a parallel activity with respect to DPR preparation. All the required steps for environment clearance shall form part of the role and responsibility of consultant, which shall remain in force till environmental clearance, is obtained.

Terms of Reference (TOR), Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) report and Environment Management Plan (EMP) shall be progressively submitted to client as and when ready.

Submission of Draft DPR:

Draft DPR along with geo technical investigation & underground mapping report will be submitted by the consultant within Six (06) weeks from acceptance of Approach Note (Pre-FR) and General layout Drawing.

Discussion on Draft DPR & General Layout and its Acceptance:

SAIL/ASP/VISL shall discuss with consultant, furnish their comments/ observations, incorporation of comments /observation by consultant and acceptance of draft DPR will be done within two (02) weeks of receipt of the Draft DPR

Submission of Final DPR:

Final DPR will be submitted by the consultant within Two (02) weeks from receipt of comments/ observations of SAIL/ASP/VISL on the Draft DPR. The same will be approved by SAIL/ASP/VISL.

The CONSULTANT shall supply but not limited to the following numbers of hard copies along with their electronic form (in DVDs/CDs/Flash Drive) in PDF & editable format using MS Office/AutoCAD:

o SAIL/ASP in triplicate.

- i) Invoice containing reference to particular installment / stage payment under the relevant Article of the AGREEMENT under which the payment has been claimed.

A certificate issued by designated authorized representative of SAIL/ASP confirming completion of relevant activity of CONSULTANT.
