- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. are the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the contract and applicable law.
