- (1) Since the indented item falls under the category of MSME Items Reserved List(Sr. no.-261) hence MSME Manufacturers should only participate in the bidding process.
- (2) After placement of GeM Contract, the successful bidder should provide an advance sample of “ **01 no. cartboy of 5 litres**” of liquid Hand Wash Soap to the consignee duly complete in all respect as per requirement along with a valid Test Certificate and get it preapproved before effecting the bulk supply.
- (3) The sample should reach the consignee within 7 working days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Govt. Holidays) after placement of Gem Contract.
- (4) Material supplied after expiry of delivery period as per GeM Contract will not be received at site.
- (5) The items to be supplied should be from the latest batch only with a minimum shelf life of 2 years from the date of supply along with valid Test Certificate.

(6) Specifications:

Soap based perfumed, regular and original soft and gentle liquid hand wash confirming to IS 4199/2001 duly packed in 5 ltrs. Virgin plastic containers. Liquid hand wash should not contain synthetic detergent for phosphates as per para 4.7.2.1 of IS 4199/2001.

PACKING

- (7) The package /container shall be legibly and indelibly marked with the following information:

 - (B) Brand name of the material and recognized trade mark, if any

The material should be supplied in Manufacturers Original packing only and not to be repacked in smaller containers. The container of liquid Hand Wash Soap should be made of virgin plastic material, tamper proof and well closed. Container with any leakage/seepage will not be accepted.

The container of liquid hand wash should be such that it is convenient to use.

(8) TESTING, INSPECTION OF SUPPLY:

Item to be supplied should be from the latest batch only with a minimum shelf life of 2 years from the date of supply along with valid test certificate. The **Test Report from NABL accredited laboratory** should be provided to prove conformity to the specifications as mentioned in the Specification Parameters and Additional Specification Parameters document as per attached Annexure-I of the indent. The Test Report must be mandatorily provided with relevant Batch No. on the Test Certificate which should match with the offered sample Liquid Soap and as well as with Bulk supplied materials.

(10) SUPPLY/PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

- 1) The complete ordered quantity to be supplied in two equal instalments strictly as per approved sample.**
- 2) Sample of 5 litres of Liquid Toilet Soap (Hand Wash) to be delivered within 7 working days of placement of GeM contract.**
- 3) First instalment to be supplied immediately after confirmation from this office regarding acceptance of sample but not later than 45 days of placement of order.**
- 4) Second instalment to be supplied after 90 days of supply of first lot or "AS AND WHEN REQUIRED BASIS" but not later than 180 days i.e, well within the Delivery Period.**
- 5) Payment will be made on Pro-rata basis after final acceptance of each supply.**

(11) Unloading of Consignment:

Unloading of consignment at consignee's site shall be the responsibility of the supplier. Personnel

engaged for unloading shall carry a valid Original Govt. approved Photo Identity proof.

(12) Security Permission for Vehicle

Vehicles with **GPS & Audio /Video Systems are not permitted** inside the premises. Vehicles delivering the consignment shall be accompanied with all relevant valid original document such as **registration certificate, fitness certificate, insurance cover, pollution clearance certificate etc.** Driver shall carry valid original driving license applicable for the vehicle.

(13) Uploading of Documents:

4. Sample Clause

After award of contract – Successful Bidder shall have to get advance sample approved from buyer before bulk manufacturing / starting bulk supplies. Successful Bidder shall submit

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samples for Buyer's approval, within 7 days of award of contract. Buyer shall, as per contract specifications framework, either approve the advance sample or will provide complete list of modification required in the sample within 15 days of receipt of advance sample. Seller shall be required to ensure supply as per approved sample with modifications as communicated by Buyer. If there is delay from buyer side in approval of advance sample – the delivery period shall be refixed without LD for the period of delay in sample approval. In case, the sample is found to have major deviations / not conforming to the Contract specifications, the buyer at its discretion may call for fresh samples for approval before allowing bulk supplies or may terminate the contract after notifying the deviations to the seller.

Unless otherwise provided in the contract, all samples required for test shall be supplied by the contractor free of cost. Where under the contract, the contractor is required to submit an advance sample, any expenses incurred by the contractor on or in connection with the production of stores in bulk, before the sample has been approved unconditionally shall be borne by the Seller and he shall not claim any compensation in the event of such sample being found unacceptable by the Buyer / Consignee.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
